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## CommunityWorks Monthly update

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### Ambulatory

#### Depression Screening Recommendation Update

- Patients diagnosed with a mental health disorder will no longer qualify for the Depression Screening Recommendation.

#### Dynamic Documentation Clinic Template Update

- The format of the medication section will be more concise.
  - The updated medication section will list out all active medication from all encounters with an order status of **Ordered**.
  - If no active medications have been documented in the chart, a message is displayed indicating **No active medications**.

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### Acute Care

#### Resuscitation Status Order


- To prevent more than one active resuscitation order at one time, duplicate order checking will be implemented, preventing patient safety issues.
  - If there is an active **Resuscitation Status** order initiated on the encounter and if the resuscitation status changes, the recommended workflow is that the physician modifies the active **Resuscitation Status** order.

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### Inpatient Nursing

#### 4AT Delirium Assessment Order

- The 4AT Delirium Assessment order is now available, linking the task to the iView documentation.
  - This will enhance the clinical workflow to support the necessary timeframe for assessment and reassessment ensuring timely identification and management of delirium.





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### Rehabilitation

#### Outpatient Rehab Rule Updates

- The Total Visit Count will increase when Total Treatment Time is documented within the OT/PT/SLP PowerForms.
- When the Evaluation Complete field is marked yes, a rule fires an order and sends a Certification letter.

- **Progress Note Visit Count** within the patient chart will be viewable, the count beginning at 0 for the certification letter workflow.
  - The rule will update the progress note visit count and notify the clinician when the progress notes should be created and sent.
    - 8 visits – discern alert generates that Progress Note will need to be completed soon.
    - 9 visits – discern alert generates that Progress Note will need to be completed, and order/task is generated.

**NOTE:** If the **Total Treatment Time** field is uncharted, that visit will not be counted toward the **Progress Note Visit Count**.

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## Surgery

### MPage Updates

- **PAT Workflow MPage** will be available for surgical preadmission staff.
  - The Preadmission form can be easily accessed and modified from **Preadmission Documentation** down.
- **Perioperative Documentation component**
  - The perioperative forms and iView bands can be easily accessed from the Preprocedure Documentation and Perioperative Documentation down arrow section.

- **Recovery and Discharge Workflow MPage** available for use.
- **Anesthesia Workflow MPage** available which includes the Preoperative checklist, Procedure information, and postoperative summary component.
- **Ambulatory Workflow (Surgery) MPage** and **Inpatient Workflow (Surgery) MPage** are added to the Provider and OB Provider workflows.

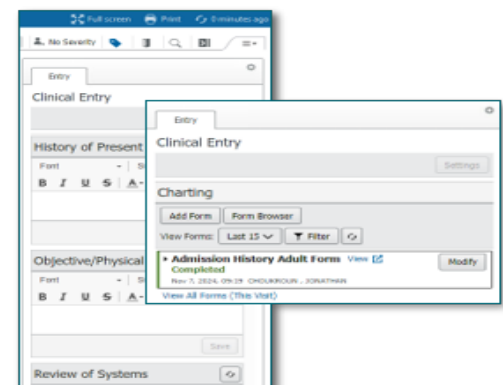
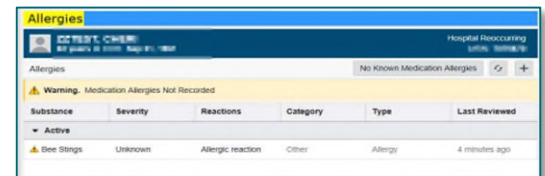
#### Pharmacy Label Update

- Updating the word Expires to Use by Date per regulatory standards.

### Future Changes

#### To Be Determined

- Allergies will be updated with a new look and feel for a more user-friendly experience.
  - No changes to the MPage component at this time, the update will occur in patient's charts, forms, scheduling appointment book, PharmNet, and RadNet.
- Reverse Interaction Checking will automatically run each time new allergies are entered and can be run at any time by clicking Reverse Allergy Check button.
  - **Interaction is found:** Red warning populates with details. This is not auto dismissed.
  - **No interaction is found:** Green checkmark with text **Success. No Drug Interaction found.** This message will auto-dismiss after five seconds.
- MyExperience Replacement
  - **MyExperience will be replaced with Role Profiles.** In the future, if more than one role exists there will be a prompt to choose a role when logging into an application.
- Clinical Entry Workspace is a new functionality called Integrated Charting which provides workflow efficiencies.
  - Located on the right side of the MPages.
  - Providers and nurses will document components that feed their Dynamic Documentation Notes and the Patient Discharge Summary.
  - Provides an efficient method to search for and open PowerForms.
    - PowerForms can be saved as a favorite.
  - View PowerForm documentation.
