Diabetes Educator

- New Diabetes Educator Assessment & Evaluation Form includes continuous glucose monitoring, insulin pump, and other diabetes specific documentation.
 - Can be found under the Ambulatory Care folder or added to favorites from the Clinical Entry Workspace.

Drug-Drug Interaction Update

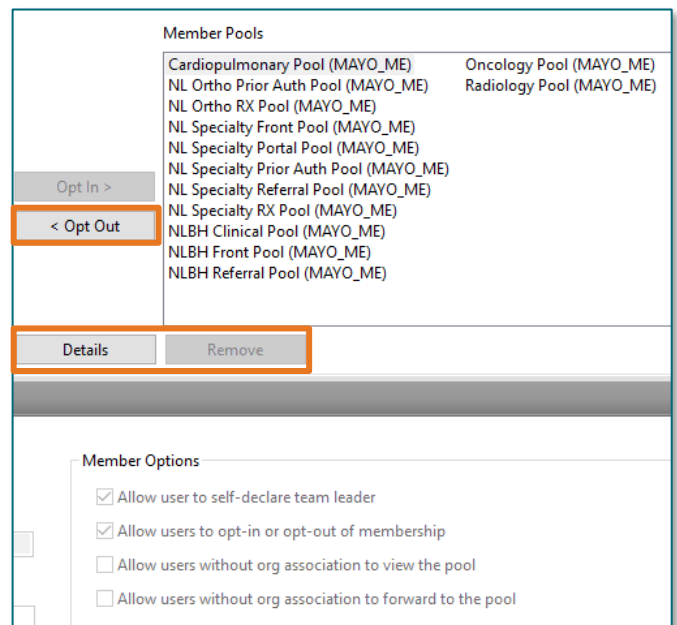
- Drug-Drug Interaction settings will now be **Major** drug-drug interactions and excluding **Generally Avoid**, **Monitor Closely**, and **Monitor** drug-drug interactions to try to reduce alert fatigue. This update is to alert only on medications that are never given together, provide a better alerting experience, and increase patient safety concerns.

Message Center Pool Membership

- Message Center Pool Membership options will require pool administrators to select if members can opt in or out of membership. To check a pool's setting within PowerChart:

- Go to Message Center and select Pools.
- Click Manage., then search for pool in available pools or click existing pool.
- Click Details, within Member Options, check whether **Allow users to opt in or opt out of membership** is selected.
 - If unselected, users cannot opt in or opt out.
 - If selected, users can opt in or opt out.

Medicare Annual Wellness Documentation

- Medicare Visit Form, Medicare Office Visit Dynamic Documentation Template, and support Smart Templates are updated to provide consistency from charting to documentation.
 - PowerForm section display order is reorganized to group sections together by Vital Signs and Measurements, Problems and Medical History, Procedures / Surgeries, Meds/Allergies, Family History, Social History, Immunization, Subjective, Review of systems, and then assessments.
 - The two former education sections are consolidated into one.
 - The two sections that were removed were Fall Risk Education that can be accessed in a separate Adhoc form if needed.
 - **Request/Accept Summary of Care Clinic removed** due to low utilization and can be accessed in separate Adhoc form if needed.
 - **Advance Directive, Mini Nutritional Assessment and SDOH screens** were added.
 - The following Smart Templates are updated to pull assessment documentation from the PowerForm in a table format in the Medicare Wellness Note:

 - Medicare Falls Risk Assessment
 - Medicare Functional Assessment
 - Medicare Get Up and Go

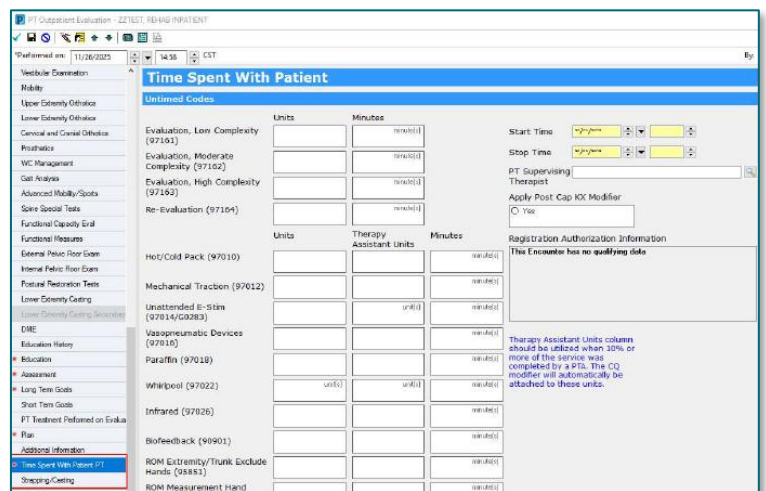
Consolidated Charge Form

- Consolidation of the **Time Spent With Patient** sections in the rehabilitation PowerForms will improve therapy workflows for dropping charges as charges and be aligned between forms (Example: Daily Documentation, Progress Notes, and Evaluations) for the same discipline and venue.

- The new sections include required fields for therapy **Start Time** and **Stop Time**.

- As part of the replacement, access to the following stand-alone PowerForm tasks are removed for Rehab positions:

- Occupational Therapy Charges
- OT Time Spent With Patient
- OT Time Spent With Patient - Inpatient
- Physical Therapy Charges
- PT Time Spent With Patient



- PT Time Spent With Patient - Inpatient
 - Speech Therapy Charges
 - SLP Time Spent With Patient
 - SLP Time Spent With Patient – Inpatient
- New tasks will remain and can be utilized by therapists to access the new consolidated PowerForms as needed:
- OT Acute TSWP
 - OT Outpatient TSWP
 - OT Inpatient TSWP
 - PT Acute TSWP
 - PT Outpatient TSWP
 - PT Inpatient TSWP
 - SLP Acute TSWP
 - SLP Outpatient TSWP

To Be Determined

- Instead of using POC PowerForms, POC result values can be entered into the Point of Care Result Entry tool.
- Reverse Interaction Checking will automatically run each time new allergies are entered and can be run at any time by clicking **Reverse Allergy Check** button.
- **Interaction is found:** Red warning populates with details. This is not auto dismissed.
 - **No interaction is found:** Green checkmark with text **Success. No Drug Interaction found.** This message will auto-dismiss after 5 seconds.
- MyExperience Replacement
- **MyExperience will be replaced with Role Profiles.** In the future, if more than one role exists there will be a prompt to choose a role when logging into an application.
