Oncology Photopheresis

With the Oncology Photopheresis band being retired, a new **Photopheresis** section has been added to the **Infusion-Oncology** iView band. Going forward, this new section will be used to capture all photopheresis treatment documentation.

Infusion-Oncology iView Band

The **Infusion-Oncology** iView band is to be used for oncology infusion documentation, in addition to other iView bands currently being used for specific items.

For the purposes of reviewing documentation, this can be achieved by reviewing in one of the following areas:

- Infusion-Oncology band
- Results Review

WHY: The Infusion-Oncology iView band, introduced during the 2023 Oncology Project, was designed to replace and consolidate the previous oncology-related bands. Retiring the older iView bands ensures a more streamlined workflow, promotes consistent documentation practices, and reduces the risk of documentation errors.



Procedure Sedation Med Admin Band Update: 1:1 Nursing Documentation – (effective 08/21/25)


