WHAT: This is a reminder regarding the correct use of the **Insertion Date/Time** field within the **Central Line** section in iView.


There have been frequent instances where the Insertion Date/Time field is used incorrectly to record **Port-a-Cath access**. Please note that this field is **intended solely to record the date and time the port was surgically inserted**, not when it is accessed for use.

WHY: The **Insertion Date/Time** field in iView is configured to automatically pull forward the most recently charted value. When this field is used to record the date and time a Port-a-Cath is accessed, rather than its intended purpose of documenting the original surgical insertion, it causes this date and time to pull forward in future documentation.

This misrepresents the actual insertion date and can lead to confusion and inaccurate information for staff involved in patient care. Ensuring correct use of this field is essential for maintaining accurate records and supporting safe, effective patient care.

HOW: • The **Insertion Date/Time** field is to be used for **documenting when a Port-a-Cath is surgically implanted in the patient**.

- When documenting activities such as port access or de-access, **make sure to accurately update the date and time in the iView column to reflect when the action occurred.**

There have been frequent instances where the Insertion Date/Time field is used incorrectly to record **Port-a-Cath access**. Please note that this field is **intended solely to record the date and time the port was surgically inserted**, not when it is accessed for use.

WHY: The **Insertion Date/Time** field in iView is configured to automatically pull forward the most recently charted value. When this field is used to record the date and time a Port-a-Cath is accessed, rather than its intended purpose of documenting the original surgical insertion, it causes this date and time to pull forward in future documentation.

This misrepresents the actual insertion date and can lead to confusion and inaccurate information for staff involved in patient care. Ensuring correct use of this field is essential for maintaining accurate records and supporting safe, effective patient care.

- HOW:**
- The **Insertion Date/Time** field is to be used for **documenting when a Port-a-Cath is surgically implanted in the patient**.
 - When documenting activities such as port access or de-access, **make sure to accurately update the date and time in the iView column to reflect when the action occurred**.
