


Valuables/Belongings/Pt Safety PowerForm

- ED nursing will document storage of patient medications on the **Valuables/Belongings/Pt Safety PowerForm**.
 - The location of the **Valuables/Belongings/Pt Safety PowerForm** can be found in **AdHoc → ED Forms**.



ED Discharge Order

- Upon patient discharge, **ED providers** are required to place the **ED Discharge** order to trigger the notification process for nursing and pharmacy to **return stored patient medications**.
 - The **ED Discharge** order can be found in **ED Quick Orders → Disposition** component.



NOTE: ED nursing will continue to receive the **Return Patient Meds** task for ED Hold patients who receive discharge orders from an inpatient provider.

Return Patients Meds Task

- Nursing will receive the **Return Patients Meds** task when the ED Discharge order is placed.
- A **Chart Done/Not Done** task will be documented.

NOTE: The **Valuables/Belongings/Pt Safety PowerForm** will need to be documented as a first step when storing a patient's home medications.

WHY: Returning a patient’s home medication at time of discharge helps to prevent medication interruptions and improve patient adherence and safety. Providing patients with their home medications upon discharge reflects our commitment to their needs, improving patient satisfaction and trust.
