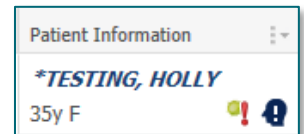
Behavior Risk Icon for ED LaunchPoint and Enhanced Tracking

WHAT: A **Behavior Risk**  icon will populate on **ED LaunchPoint** and **Enhanced Tracking** when a patient has a **Patient Behavior Safety Flag**.

- Staff should check with the patient's nurse before entering the patient room when the icon is displayed.

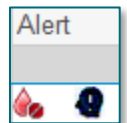
ED LaunchPoint

- The **Behavior Risk** icon will populate in the **Patient Information** column of **ED LaunchPoint**.



Enhanced Tracking

- The **Behavior Risk** icon will populate in the **Alert** column of **Enhanced Tracking**.



WHY: The addition of the **Behavior Risk** icon helps close communication gaps by alerting ancillary and contracted staff to potential safety concerns and prompting them to check with the patient's nurse before entering the patient room.

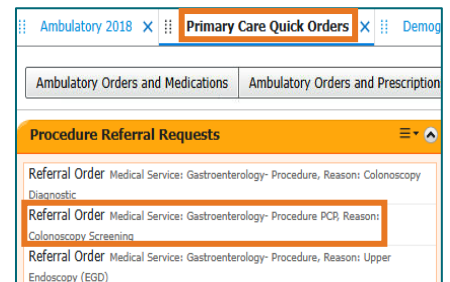
PCP Colonoscopy Screening Referral Update – SVH
