

BH Child and Adolescent Intake PowerForm Update

WHAT: The Advance Directive and Psychiatric Advance Directive sections will be added to the BH Child and Adolescent Intake PowerForm used at Admission.

Inpatient Pediatrics

The **Surrogate name and contact number** should be documented in **both** the Advance Directive and Psychiatric Advance Directive sections.

NOTE: For a pediatric patient, the Surrogate decision maker would be the same person signing the Medication Consents.

These sections are currently in the BH Intake Assessment Adult form.

WHY: NL Acadia Hospital participates in The Inpatient Psychiatric Quality Facility Reporting (IPFQR) CMS Program which requires that patients of all ages are asked at admission if they have a Surrogate decision maker and/or Advance Care Directive/Psychiatric Advance Care Directive, and if not, the patient is offered information on these topics, or a declination is documented.

Cerner Patient Observer (CPO) Camera Downtime

WHAT: Virtual Observation Cameras are being Upgraded

- Cameras will be upgraded one at a time.
- During the camera upgrade, the cameras will be out of service for 10 -15
 minutes and the patient will not be able to be observed by the CPO staff
 during this time.
- The CPO staff will notify the nurse when their patient's camera will be offline during the upgrade and again when it is back online.

WHY: Cerner Patient Observer is being upgraded to level 2.9. The cameras and Central Monitoring Stations will be upgraded, bringing new functionality, increasing automated communication to the Cerner Patient Observer technician and efficiency in their workflow.




