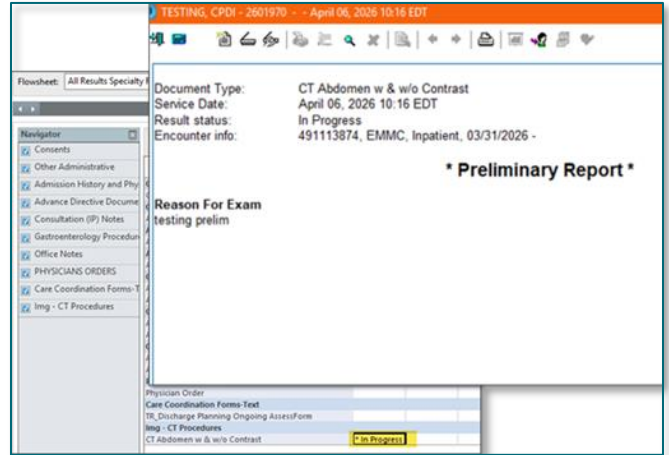

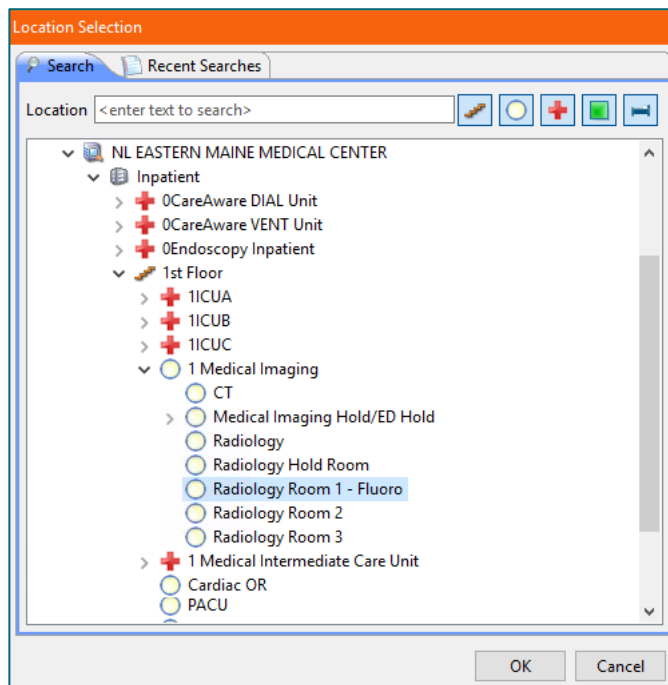

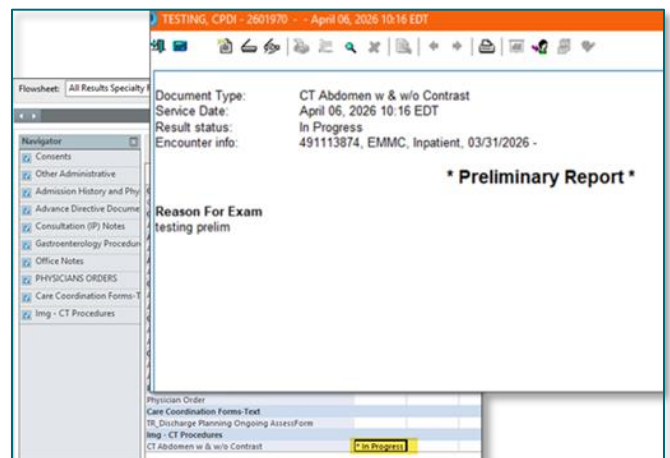

WHY: The current **Infusion Clinic Lines and Tubes** iView band contains older versions of several dynamic groups, including Central Line, GI Tubes, and Urinary Catheter. Other venues within the system are using updated versions of these same dynamic group sections. These inconsistencies have made it challenging for staff to quickly locate documentation across venues and encounters.

As part of the Oncology Project in 2023, the **Infusion–Oncology** iView band was created for the oncology locations. This updated band was designed to consolidate documentation into a single, standardized band to streamline documentation, enhance visibility across all locations, improve workflow efficiency, and support consistent documentation practices system-wide.

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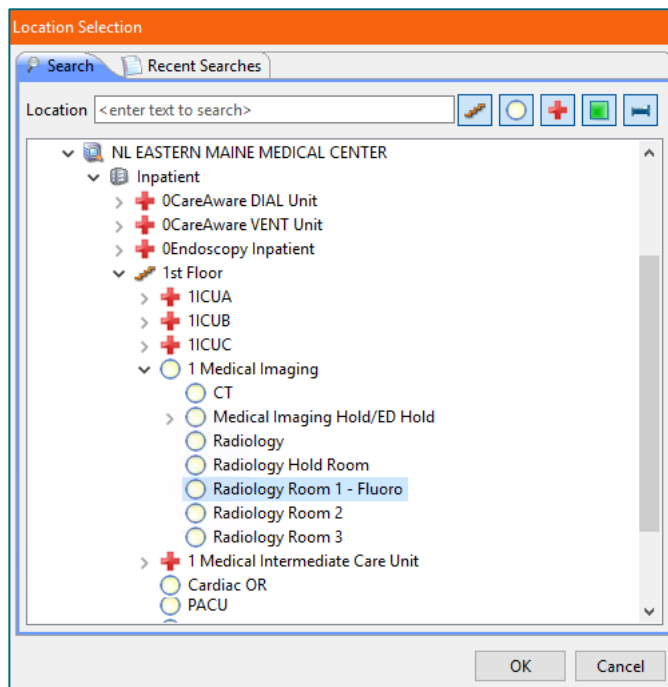

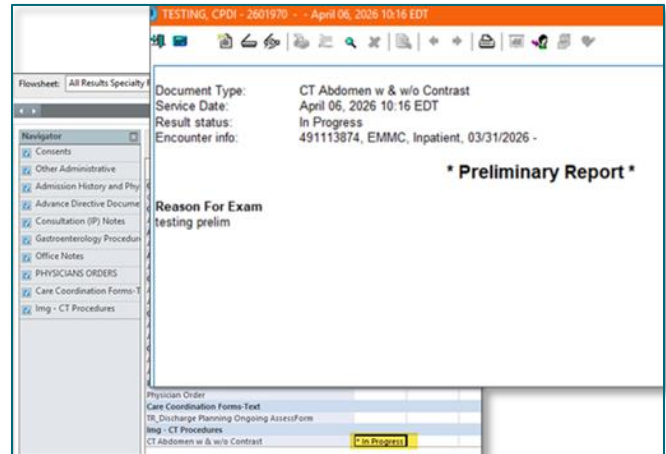
