End User Validation allows staff who have not been involved in the project to see the changes, document in the new build in our **MOCK** domain before it is implemented. Staff can document the workflow, identify any breaks in the documentation. It is not meant to be a design session.

What to expect

During EUV, a Health Informaticist will work one-on-one with staff at their convenience/when they become available. The Informaticist will assist participants with signing into the Mock domain, help them identify changes, and answer questions. The Informaticist will document any issues that are discovered. Issues will be submitted to the Northern Light/Oracle (Cerner) project team for discussion/resolution. Please note that while Health Informatics will not be able to visit everyone, care will be taken to obtain feedback from as many participants from each group, as possible.

Update Details

- The Centralized Refill Team will use the **/Healthfinch** auto text to add the information from Embedded Refill Management into refill-related **Message Center** messages.
- When all protocol criteria have been met, a Central Refill Team member will send the refill to the retail pharmacy using the **Patient Care Protocol-Co-Signature Required** communication type. Prescription refills are sent concurrently to the retail pharmacy for refill, and the provider for co-signature. Co-signature is not required prior to these refills.
- When protocol requirements have not been met, a Central Refill Team member will either propose the refill to the provider and/or forward a message to the provider/clinical and/or clerical pool concurrently for review and actions.

Embedded Refill Decision Support – NL Women’s Health (AR Gould Only)

WHAT: **Embedded Refill Management** “Healthfinch” will be made available for medication renewal requests at NL Women’s Health Presque Isle as part of additional services provided by the **Centralized Refill Team**.

Update Details

- The Centralized Refill Team will use the **/Healthfinch** auto text to add the information from Embedded Refill Management into refill-related **Message Center** messages.
- When all protocol criteria have been met, a Central Refill Team member will send the refill to the retail pharmacy using the **Patient Care Protocol-Co-Signature Required** communication type. Prescription refills are sent concurrently to the retail pharmacy for refill, and the provider for co-signature. Co-signature is not required prior to these refills.
- When protocol requirements have not been met, a Central Refill Team member will either propose the refill to the provider and/or forward a message to the provider/clinical and/or clerical pool concurrently for review and actions.
