- **BH Inpatient Treatment Plan** is being enhanced to include more structured focus areas for goals and objectives, along with required fields to support thorough and consistent documentation.
 - Focus Areas for Goals and Objectives include **Psychiatric, Medical Care, Discharge/Planning and Other.**

This has led to incorrect product selection, dosing inconsistencies, and an increased risk of medication errors. This update will directly fix the current APA issues with Neonatal IV Morphine.
