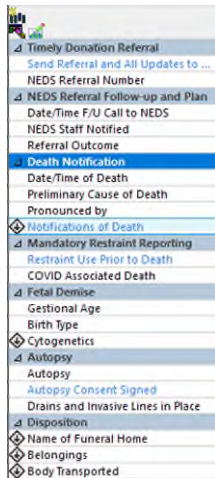


Expiration Record Reminder

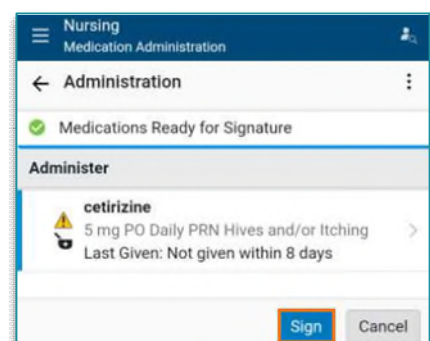
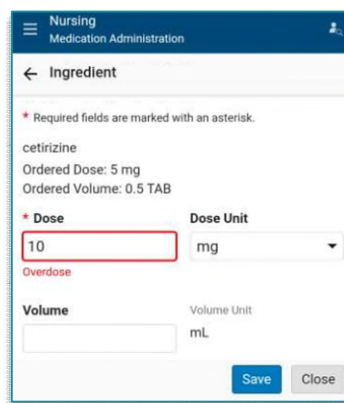
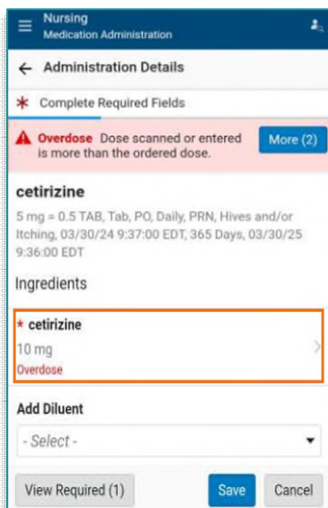
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CareAware – Changing Medication Dose

Medication volume and dose can be changed from the Connect Device by selecting the medication, scrolling down to the **Ingredients** section, and changing the amount within that section.



Documenting POC Pregnancy Tests in Procedural Areas

A field for **Urine Pregnancy POC Result** is in the Preprocedure Checklist forms. The field should only be used if a POC test was performed. The field is NOT to be used to document a pregnancy test that was performed and resulted by the lab.

Documenting in this area documents a POC Pregnancy result which is visible within Results Review.

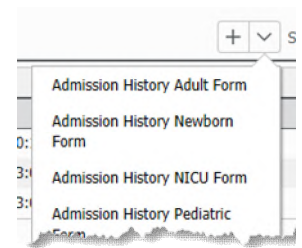

Accessing PowerForms from MPages

When accessing PowerForms through the MPage, please note that these open the *same* each time. For example, if a patient is having two surgeries done during their inpatient stay, staff needs to access the Preprocedure Checklist Form from adhoc for the second surgery because the MPage will open the form documented for their first surgery as if to modify.
