The Controlled Substances component gives providers the ability to review Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) reports within Cerner. The reports are available to providers and pharmacists only. Registered nurses and medical assistants will continue to review PMP by proxy on the Prescription Monitoring Program website.

PDMP Review

PDMP Review is found in the **Opioid Review** component on the Workflow MPage.

STEP 1: Navigate to the appropriate Workflow MPage.

Click the Opioid Review component.

STEP 2: Within PDMP Review, select View Report.



<u>NOTE</u>: Selecting View Report notifies the State the Provider has viewed the Patient's PDMP Report.

STEP 3: Review Opioid Treatment Agreement

 Yes indicates Missing Opioid Treatment Agreement.

• **No** indicates no further action.

<u>STEP 4</u>: Click the **Open** button to the right of **Opioid Review** and click the **dropdown** to select **Opioid Treatment Agreement**.

- PDMP Review Terms of Use populates.
- After reviewing the Terms of Use, click **Accept** or Cancel.

NOTE: Once the Terms of Use is accepted, the PDMP report expands and displays demographic


information, risk indicator graphs, and prescription information (summary of total

prescriptions, total prescribers, and total

pharmacies).


STEP 5: Complete **PDMP Review**.

 After reviewing PDMP Review, ensure the checkbox to the left of I certify that I have reviewed the PDMP Information is selected.

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<u>NOTE</u>: The checkbox will be automatically selected after the report is reviewed.

STEP 6: Click the **Mark as Reviewed** button.



 Mark as Reviewed confirms the provider has reviewed PDMP, including a timestamp which is used for reporting purposes.

NOTE: The PMP Component will be removed in an upcoming update. Providers are encouraged to remove the component from view to prevent accidental use.
