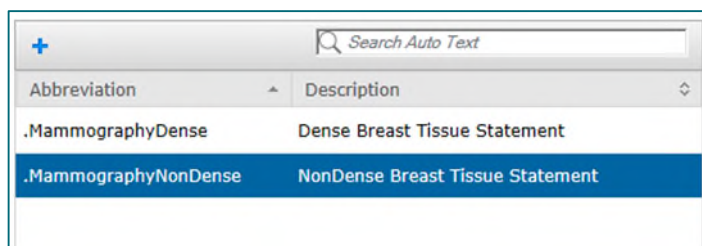
➤ **Conditions that help qualify patients for certain recommendations will be updated.**

Routes of Administration Update

➤ Certain Routes of Administration will be updated. Pharmacy has reviewed and overseen recommendations for replacement. This has been completed in phases since April.

- The following routes have been updated since April:

Route Inactivated	Replacement
IA	Intra-articular
Continuous Nerve Catheter	Perineural
Peripheral Nerve Catheter	Perineural
Dubhoff	Nasogastric or Orogastric
Enteral	Gastrostomy, jejunostomy, nasoduodenal, nasogastric, nasojejunal, oral, orogastric, rectal
Tube	Gastrostomy, jejunostomy, nasoduodenal, nasogastric, nasojejunal, oral, orogastric, rectal
Extradural	Epidural
Incisional/Surgical Site	Irrigation
INH in Line	Inhale or Nebulized inhalation
Injectable	Intra-articular, intramuscular, subcutaneous, etc.
IntPosPB	Inhale or Nebulized inhalation
Intracavitary	Intravesical, intraperitoneal, intrapleural
IPven	Inactivated – no replacement
Kit-combo	Inactivated – no replacement
IVBuretrol	IV Continuous and add a comment if pump type is needed
Nasal	Nostril-Both, Nostril-Left, Nostril-Right, Nostril-Alternating Nares, or Nostril-Either
Percutaneous	Transdermal or Sub
Relative to H2O	Inactivated – no replacement

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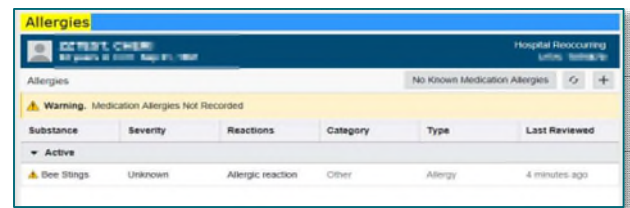
Retrobulbar Block	Intraocular
SI Joint	Intra-articular
Spinal	Intrathecal
Ureteral	Inactivated – no replacement

To Be Determined

- Allergies will be updated to a more user-friendly experience. The update will occur in patient's charts, forms, scheduling appointment book, PharmNet, and RadNet.

- There will be no change to workflow MPages at this time.

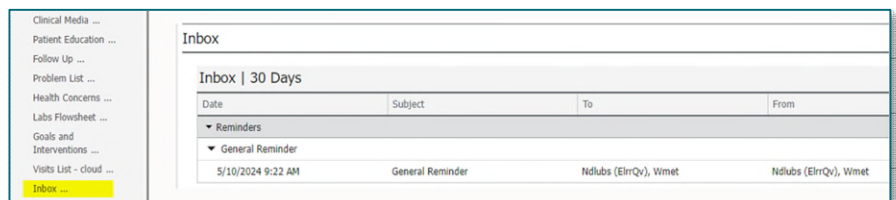


- Reverse Interaction Checking will automatically run each time new allergies are entered and can also be run at any time to check by clicking Reverse Allergy Check button.

- If interaction is found, a red warning populates with details. This is not auto dismissed.
- If no interaction is found, a green checkmark with text, **Success. No Drug Interaction found.** This message will auto dismiss after five seconds.

- Inbox Component will be available to view, compose, or reply to messages from the workflow MPage.

- This is not a replacement or a copy of functionality to the Message Center. This component on the MPage is intended for the clinician to perform a quick review of messages and reminders for a patient. Concurrent with the clinician review, there is a quick action of composing messages and/or reminders from the component chart view as needed.
