



# From the Office of Health Informatics Oracle Health (Cerner) Millennium Advanced Growth Chart June 20, 2025

The Advanced Growth Chart is a useful tool for clinicians and clinical staff to document, track, and assess the growth and development of pediatric, newborn, and pre-term patients.

### **Advanced Growth Chart**

The Advanced Growth Chart component is visible on the Amb Pediatrics 2018 MPage. The component displays results in a flowsheet format. Clicking the **Header** of the component will open the Growth Chart in the Table of Contents to view the results compared to the percentile growth curves on a graph. This view allows for editing of views and providing additional documentation that affects the results.






### **➢** Bone Age Entry

- To add a Bone Age Entry, from the Growth Chart view, click the **Enter New** dropdown.
- Select **Bone Age**.



- The **Bone Age** PowerForm will display. Enter the appropriate values, then save the form by clicking the **green checkmark** icon.
- The added values will now display on the Advanced Growth Chart.




### ➤ Mid Parental Height (MPH) Entry

 To add a MPH Entry, from the Growth Chart view, click the Enter New dropdown.



- Click MPH.
- The Mid Parental Height PowerForm will display. Enter in the appropriate values then save the form by clicking the green checkmark icon.



## Viewing Results

- Bone Age will display with a **Delta Sign** on the graph.
- MPH will be indicated with an arrow on the right-hand side of the graph at the calculated height.


# Changing Views

 The Advanced Growth Chart grid can be changed to display different information as appropriate by selecting the Change View button



 The Change View window will open. Selections in this window will affect how the grid displays information.





### > Changing the Advanced Growth Chart Component Display

- From the MPage, the Advanced Growth Chart component can be chaged to display a different scale.
- Click the button with the three lines on the right of the window and select the desired view.
