### Workflow MPages

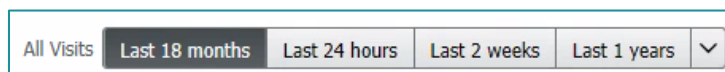
#### Overview





##### What are Workflow MPages?

- Workflow MPages are interactive, visually rich views that allow staff to review real-time clinical information in one area.
- Many of the actions you must take to deliver care can be initiated directly from the view, which decreases required clicks and reduces navigation barriers.
- The same information found in a **Summary MPage** component will be found in the respective Workflow MPage Component.
- You can personalize your views and content within components so they are presented with the information at the point you need it during your natural workflow.

#### MPage Elements


- The following elements can be used within the components to assist with locating information efficiently in the patient's chart.
  - **Workflow View:** Displays the Workflow components.
  - **Workflow Component:** Allows you to review different types of patient results/information.
  - **Component Header:** Clicking the component header allows you to navigate to the appropriate section of the patient's chart to where you can view information, as needed. 
  - **Look-Back Ranges:** These buttons allow you to select the timeframe for which you want to see results in the component. For example, click **Last 24 Hours** to display the appropriate patient information in the component for the last 24 hours.

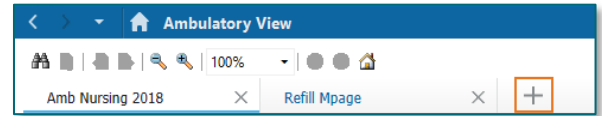


- **Add** : Opens a dialog box or a section of the patient's chart where you can document additional information.
- **Additional Actions** : Displays a list of additional actions, PowerForms, or other items available in the component.
- **Refresh** : Displays how much time has elapsed since the data in the component was last refreshed. Click this button to manually refresh the component information.
- **Component-Level Menu** : Displays additional filtering and display options for the component

## Customizing the Workflow MPage

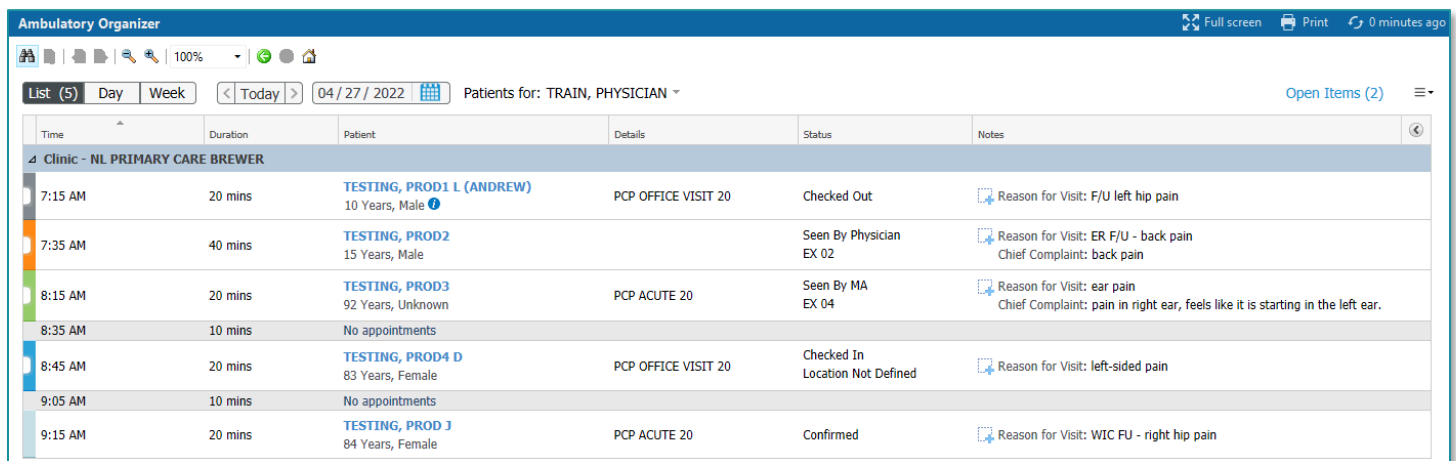
### Add MPages to View

- Click the **Add**  button on the view.
- Select the desired MPage to be added.



## Ambulatory Organizer

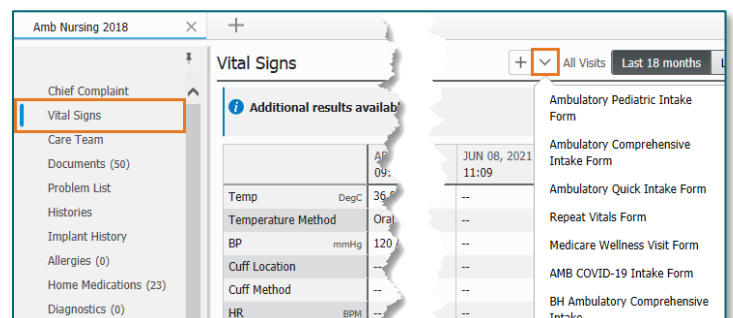
- The **Ambulatory Organizer** provides a simple, comprehensive view for Ambulatory staff to efficiently access and manage their patient schedule, documentation, and charges.
- The Ambulatory Organizer also provides a snapshot of a single day's appointments, as well as any appointment gaps and appointment times and details, patient information and status.

## Patient Intake Process

- Accessing the Intake form is more efficient and time saving!
- To access the intake form:
  - From the **Ambulatory Organizer**, click the patient's name.
    - The chart opens to Ambulatory View.
  - From the Workflow MPage, navigate to the **Vital Signs** component.
  - Click the **Add** drop-down arrow.



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- Select and complete appropriate Intake form.
- Complete the intake as per your normal process.


### Patient Education

- If **This Visit** problems have been documented for the patient, the **Quick Suggestions** section of the Patient Education component displays suggestions based on those problems.
- Education items can be added by selecting a suggested education item or by searching for and adding an education item that was not suggested.

- For **Suggested Education Items:**

- Simply select the education item in the **Quick Suggestions** section that you want to add.
- The education item is added and displays in the **Added Education** section of the component.

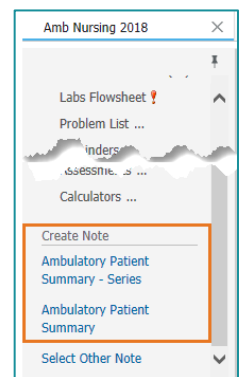

- If you wish to add an education item that is not listed in the **Quick Suggestions** section, click **Add**  in the component heading
- The **Add Education** dialog box displays. Search for the desired education topic.
  - Select the education item you want to add. The education item is added and displays in the **Added Education** section of the component.

### Patient Visit Summary

- With the position uplift, the Depart tool will be retired. Patient visit summaries will be generated from the Workflow MPage.
- Instructions that providers enter in the **Patient Instructions** component on their Workflow MPage will flow to the **Instructions From Your Provider** section of the Visit Summary.
- Staff have the ability to add additional instructions to this section when generating the Visit Summary.

**NOTE:** For patient visits on Series encounters, staff will select the **Ambulatory Patient Summary – Series** option in the Quick Links when generating the Visit Summary.

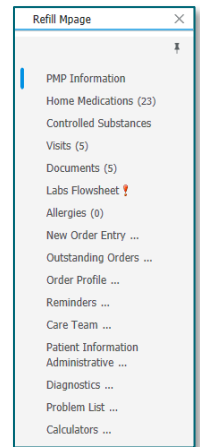
## Helpful MPages

### Demographics MPage

- The **Demographics MPage** provides helpful information such as insurance, registration, contact information, and more in one location.
- Information entered on the **Patient Information Administrative Form** is populated into the Patient Information Administrative component on the Demographics MPage.

### Refill MPage

- The **Refill MPage** is another workflow MPage that contains components pertinent to reviewing a patient's chart for prescription refills. Staff can also view this page from the message in Message Center by clicking **Summary View**.



### Referral Review MPage

- The **Referral Review MPage** allows staff reviewing incoming referrals to view information in the patient's chart in a single location.

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## Default Location in Message Center

- It is important to associate the correct location when creating a Between Visit encounter as this will ensure task and orders are placed correctly.

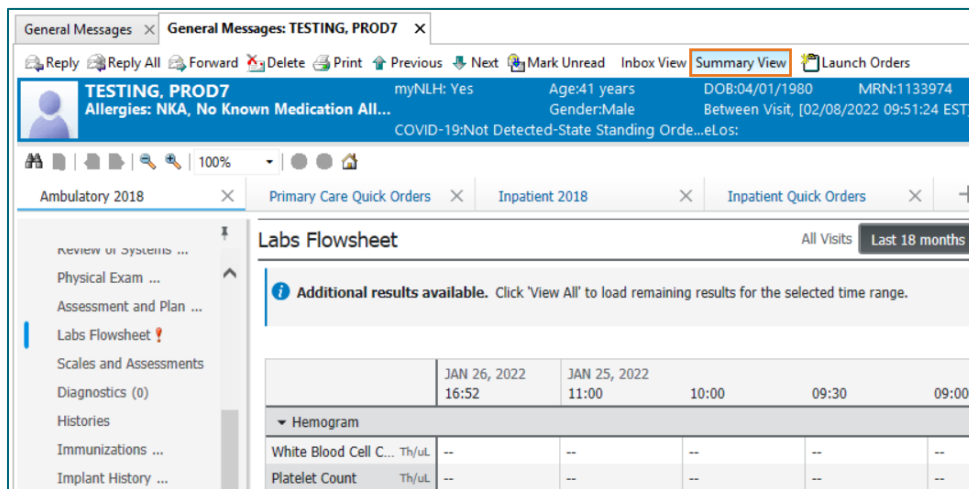

### Summary View

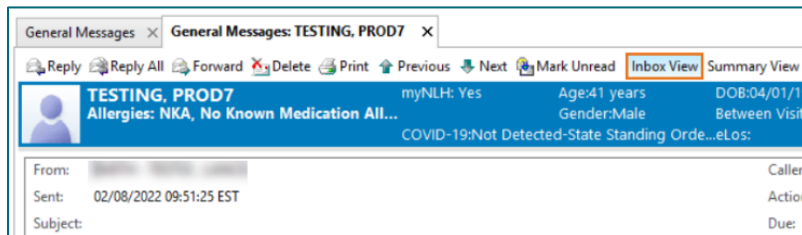
- The **Summary View** button within Message Center is an efficient and convenient way to open and review a patient's chart, without having to navigate out of Message Center and go into the patient's chart.
- To access Summary View:

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- Open a message and click **Summary View** on the header toolbar of the message.



- The **Summary View** opens in the Ambulatory View. You can navigate to the desired section of the workflow MPage.
- To get back to your Inbox, click the **Inbox View** tab to the left of the Summary View.
