As Northern Light Health continues to focus on quality initiatives to reduce pressure ulcers, wound photography provides an objective assessment of an identified wound. Wound photo(s) should be uploaded to the patient's Wound Care folder using Camera Capture.

<u>STEP 1</u> : <u>STEP 2</u> :	 Log in to Camera Capture Phone Application. Open the Camera Capture app. Log in with PowerChart username and password. Tap Log In. Quick Access PIN Setup. A quick access PIN is unnecessary, skip this step the first-time logging into the app. To bypass the Quick Access PIN Setup. 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- **<u>STEP 5</u>**: Complete Details
 - Tap the Name field to rename the photo the same as the Dynamic Group will appear in iView.
 - Label the wound photograph with the wound number (1, 2, 3, etc.).
 - Wound anatomical location.
 - Laterality (Left or Right).



Log Out

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<u>NOTE</u>: Wound Number, Location, and Laterality should match the wound's dynamic group in iView.

- After selecting to keep the photo, save images in the Wound Care folder.
- **<u>STEP 6</u>**: Save Selection
 - Tap **Save** after all appropriate choices or tap **Cancel** if you do not want to keep the image.
 - Tap **Done** in the lower right-hand corner.
- **<u>STEP 7</u>**: Logging out of Camera Capture.
 - Tap the **Settings** icon in the lower right-hand corner.
 - Then tap **Log Out**.

Viewing Photos in PowerChart

Photos saved to the patient's encounter and are accessible in Oracle Health (Cerner) by navigating to the Media Gallery component on Workflow MPage(s).

NOTE: For Inpatient Nursing staff, the Media Gallery component is accessible via the nurse view – Handoff MPage.
