

# From the Office of Health Informatics Cerner Millennium THA/TKA Patient-Reported Outcomes June 23, 2025

THA/TKA Patient-Reported Outcomes is a regulatory documentation requirement for those patients who have a Total Hip or Total Knee Arthroplasty. The goal of documenting this information is to measure improvement in a patient's self-assessment of their pain and functional status.

## Who Should Have This Documentation Completed

- Patient is undergoing an elective total hip arthroplasty (THA) or elective total knee arthroplasty (TKA), including bilateral (same day) procedures.
- ➤ Patient who is enrolled in **Medicare fee-for-service** (Medicare Advantage Patients are excluded).
- > Patient is **age 65 years** or **older**.

NOTE: Failure to document this form when the patient meets the above criteria results in financial penalities for the hospital.


### **Documentation to be Completed Preoperatively**

- ➤ The entire **THA/TKA Patient Reported Outcomes PowerForm** should be documented **0-90 days prior** to the procedure.
- > KOOS, JR. Adult Knee Survey section
  - Documented if a patient is having a **TKA**.
- HOOS, JR. Adult Hip Survey section
  - Documented if a patient is having a THA.
- **Preoperative documentation** is completed by:
  - AR Gould and MCH
    - Completed by the Orthopedic practice.
  - Mercy
    - Completed by the Mercy Orthopedic practice.
    - Completed by PAT if provider is NOT employed by NLH.

# **Documenting the THA/TKA Patient-Reported Outcomes PowerForm**

- ➤ In the first section, documenting **Preoperative Survey** or **Postoperative Survey** in **Survey Type** will open the **Generic PROM Version** box for selecting the Promis Global Version 1.2 for documentation.
  - Documentation of the PROMIS Global 10 section is only required preoperatively.

- ➤ Documentation of **Left** or **Right hip replacement** in **THA Procedure Type** will open the **HOOS, JR. Adult Survey** section for documentation.
- Documentation of Left or Right knee replacement in TKA Procedure Type will open the KOOS, JR. Adult Survey section for documentation.



# **Documentation to be Completed Postoperatively**

- ➤ Documentation should occur 300-425 days postoperatively.
- Sections to be completed postoperatively:
  - THA/TKA Patient-Reported Outcomes
  - KOOS, JR. Adult Knee Survey
    - Documented if a patient is having a TKA.
  - HOOS, JR. Adult Knee Survey
    - Documented if a patient is having a THA.
- Postoperative documentation is completed by:
  - AR Gould and MCH
    - Completed by the Orthopedic practice.
