FetaLink is an application used by clinicians to monitor maternal and fetal data during the different phases of labor. FetaLink allows for data to be displayed in a meaningful and useful format to clinicians in the ambulatory and inpatient settings.

Documentation Integration

Ambulatory practices will document the Fetal Monitoring episode after the Non-Stress Test order has been placed from the WH Quick Order MPage by entering a **Reason for Monitoring** and any necessary nursing annotations in FetaLink.



Documentation in FetaLink

- Documenting Reason for Monitoring:
 - Associate the patient to the monitor.
 - From the Census view, click the column Reason for Monitoring.
 - Associate the patient to the correct encounter.
 - Click Reason for Monitoring.
 - Click the reason for monitoring from the provided list.
 - Click OK.

NOTE: During the monitoring episode, address any alerts and create an annotation.

- Creating an Annotation for an alert:
 - Click the paper clip icon.
 - Select options from the quick picks.
 - If the options aren't appropriate, free text in the annotation box.



- This information will display in FetaLink as an Annotation.






Extended View

> Finalizing the Fetal Monitoring Episode

• When the fetal monitoring episode is complete, the patient will be taken off the monitor and the episode will be finalized.

Monitor Association Finalize

- Select Finalize.
- Review/Update the Reason for Monitoring and select Yes.




> Single Patient Task List

- After the fetal monitoring episode has been finalized, review the patient's **Single Patient Task List**.
- From the drop down, select **Done**.
- Complete the form, as appropriate, and click the green checkmark to sign the form.








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
Antenatal Testing Note

- From the Prenatal MPage, select the **OB Antenatal Testing** Note.
- If being initiated by nursing, nursing will review the information and Save the Note.

- Navigate to Notes (on the Table of Contents), locate the note initiated by nursing and click the person icon.
- Forward the note to the provider for signature by selecting Sign in the Additional Forward Action drop down.
- The provider will review the note in their Message Center prior to signing.
