

From the Office of Clinical Informatics Women's Health **Transcribed Prenatal Labs** June 11, 2020


On August 17, 2020, PowerChart Maternity will go-live. The implementation of this solution will cross from the ambulatory to the inpatient setting improving the continuity of care provided throughout the patient's pregnancy and ensures all members of the healthcare team have access to information necessary for delivering high-quality care. This flyer will demonstrate where to document outside prenatal labs.

Transcribed Prenatal Labs

Lab results from organizations outside Northern Light Health are documented in the Ad Hoc folder titled Transcribed Prenatal Lab Form.

Transcribed Prenatal Lab Form


From Ad Hoc, select Transcribed Prenatal Lab Form




On the first tab, change the date to reflect the date that the lab was performed.



After changing the date, click "Yes" and select the facility where the lab was performed.



There are two tabs that have lab results on them to select from: Transcribed Prenatal Lab Results and Outside Labs- Genetic Screening.



Lab results will be entered via a radio button, gree-text, or in a graph format.

• When entering lab results in the graph, click **Negative** and all results will then populate with a **Negative** result. If there was a positive among the negatives, you can click the cell for that result and it will change that result to a positive.





- There are multiple results on each tab, be sure to use the scroll on the right-hand side to see fields for all lab results.
- When all labs are completed, sign the form on the upper left-hand corner using the green checkmark.

NOTE: A new form needs to be completed for each date of service.

➤ Viewing Lab Results

- In the Prenatal Labs and Tests Components, you can view the results that were entered as transcribed prenatal labs.
- These will display with Outside Lab in front of the name of the test.



In addition, they are viewable in Results Review.
