The Women's Health View has two different MPages with different components in each MPage. This flyer will review the ambulatory workflow MPages for Women's Health.

Women's Health View

In the ambulatory practices, there are two MPages that focus on Women's Health.

> Prenatal

 From this page, add the pregnancy. After the pregnancy is added, the components will be available for use.



Add Pregnancy

- Adding a pregnancy.
 - Click Add a Pregnancy.
 - Enter an Onset date.
 - Select Use as LMP Date.
 - Enter a Confirmation Method, i.e. Home Pregnancy Test.
 - Estimated due date (EDD) and estimated gestational age (EGA) will auto populate based on the information entered.

- Pregnancy Overview
 - Information from the current pregnancy will display based on the information in the chart when the pregnancy was opened.
 - The information will update as the pregnancy progresses with an updated EGA and weight and BMI.



• Chief Complaint

- The Chief Complaint or reason that the patient states they are there. The information is free texted in this field.
- This is a free text field with a 255-character limit.
- Click Sign when done. The provider can add to this field and/or update the information.



- OB Actions and Situational Awareness
 - The area allows the documentation of concerns for the patient and the planning for addressing the concerns. These will be seen across encounters and not associated with any other part of PowerChart.





Risk Factors (3)

- These comments provide the ability to enter information that aids in the care of a patient for one's medical service or medical service care team for the current encounter.
- Only the four most recent comments are displayed in the component. If there are more than
 four comments available, click Show All to view the other comments. Click Show Less to hide
 the other comments and view only the four most recent comments.
- To view comments available to all care teams, click View All in the Actions and Situational Awareness section.

NOTE: This information is not viewable after the pregnancy is closed.


- Risk Factors
 - The component will populate risk factors that have been identified as related to the pregnancy.
 - Providers will enter this information on the form found in the Risk Factors Component.





Problem List


- The list will display the patient's problem list.
- These are displayed by Active, Resolved, Chronic, and All Previous and This Visit Problems.
- Problems from the risk factors will be indicated by the conversation icon.
- Pregnancy Visit Information
 - The view is created by clicking Add Visit.

This can be displayed in two views: card format or flowsheet view.





• Information found here is like the information found on the ACOG form.

Documents

- The component will display documents for the patient.
- The number of documents available are indicated by the number in parentheses.
- There are filters for the type of documents being viewed as well as for the timeframe.



Home Medications

• The list will display the patient's current home medication list.



- When clicking Med History, it will take you to the Document Medication by History tool.
- Review the home medications and complete the compliance comments.
- While in this tool, complete the preferred pharmacy workflow and verify the patient's preferred pharmacy.
- When this is completed, a green checkmark will indicate the med history has been completed for this patient.



 Medication history must be completed for the provider to complete their medication reconciliation.

Histories

- From the MPages, the histories are view only.
- Histories that are viewable are: Problems, Procedure, Family, Social and Pregnancy.



To make updates to any of these histories, click the header and it will open the histories tool.


- Prenatal Labs and Tests
 - Prenatal lab results will display by trimester.
 - This is based on the onset date and may not reflect the "actual" trimester.

Prenatal Labs & Tests MR Results for indicated lab fall outside of the recommended gestational age range and may be selected to fulfill this range. Results Orders

Results Timeline

Results Timeline

- The component will display results from the onset date of the pregnancy to the estimated due date.
- On the timeline, it will display visits, labs and microbiology, ultrasounds, monitoring episodes, and treatments.
- Icons will display whether the visit type is Outpatient, Inpatient, Observation/Triage, and ED.
- When clicking an icon, more information will display to the right.




• EDD Maintenance

- This component will display the EDD, EDD Method, and the Ultrasound EGA.
- When a patient has an ultrasound performed, click the + sign and add the Ultrasound information.
- Check the Use this estimate for EDD calculations box.



- The updated date will appear with a checkmark to indicate this is the authoritative date to use.
- Modify the EDD
 - Click the **Modify EDD** blue font in the component.
 - Click Confirmed Pregnancy in the top window to highlight in blue.
 - Modify as needed (Date of Method)



- Delete a Pregnancy can be done in the same manner, click **Delete**.
 - Delete would be used if documentation was on the wrong patient.

NOTE: These changes are for the current pregnancy, any other changes to pregnancy history would be done from the history's component.

Labs Flowsheet

- The flowsheet will display all labs that the patient has had during a specified timeframe based on the filter selected.
- The labs will be broken down by category and will display if the values are not in range.




Diagnostics

- Will display any diagnostics that the patient has had during a specified timeframe based on the filter selected.
- Will be broken down by category of the diagnostic testing.

Media Gallery

- This component will display media attachments performed during a specified timeframe based on the filter selected.
- To view the media item, select the category and then click the item.



Fetal Monitoring

- All episodes that have been archived will be seen in this component.
- The number of episodes in the chart will be indicated by the number in parentheses.

- This will be listed by episode.
- Details that populate are start and stop of the episode, EGA, and Reason for Monitoring.
- Click the box to the left of the desired episode
 - a launch icon will appear so the provider can review the strip.

• Birth Plan

- This component will display information from the Antepartum Intake form and can be updated throughout the pregnancy.
- To update, information can be added from the component by clicking the drop-down arrow and completing the form.

• Genetic Screening


- This will display the genetic screening that will indicate the genetic risk for the patient.
- The form can be completed as part of the Antepartum Intake during the initial visit.

Launch Clear

- Updates can be made from the plus sign in the component.
- Scales and Assessments
 - The Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Scale will display in this component.
 - The form is available from the drop down within the component.

• Outstanding Orders

- Orders that are in the patient's order profile that haven't been completed will display in this component.
- This can be useful to know that something that has been ordered to avoid duplicate order entry.

New Order Entry

- Orders can be placed via this component or via the WH Quick Orders page.
- The folders displayed on this page are the same the Quick Orders page.




Immunizations

• The component will display immunizations given to the patient and if they have immunizations due for.

• Recommendations

 The Recommendations component will display preventative healthcare items the patient is due for based on their age and diagnosis.



• Recommendations can be satisfied via documentation.

Obstetrics Trimester Education


 Education that has been provided and documented via Interactive View and I&O will be displayed here.



- The education may not display in the anticipated trimester, as the trimester is based on the date documented as the onset date.
- Several sections documented in Interactive View and I&O, populate more than one trimester.
- To document education, click the drop down in the component and select **OB Office Visit** and it will navigate to Interactive View and I&O, select the **Antepartum Education** band.

• Patient Education

- Suggested education will display here based on the patient's problem list.
- At least one suggested education topic should be given to the patient at their visit.
- If the desired education isn't one of the suggested education topics, click More Options and search for education.
- Education for Medication can also be found here by clicking More Options and select the header Medication Leaflets.





Health Concerns

- Health Concerns are based on the patient's individual needs and are categorized.
- These categories include behavioral, community, family, financial, physiologic, and safety.
- Categories are selected from the drop down.
- These are free text items that can be updated at any time.

Goals and Interventions


- Like Health Concerns these are based on the patient's individual needs.
- The patient and provider set a goal and how they will achieve that goal.
- Barriers to meeting the goal are identified.
- These are reviewed and updated as appropriate.

• Care Team

This is currently used for inpatient care.

Gyn Clinic

- The page is like the Prenatal MPage.
- The one different component is the **Gynecology** component.
- Gynecology
 - This component features Gynecology History, Menses (OB/GYN), Domestic Violence (OB/GYN), OB Pregnancy History, and Ungrouped Nonsequenced Results.





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• From the drop down, select the **GYN Visit** template to complete the GYN Intake.



Create Note

- Based on the MPage you are on, the note types available may vary.
 - Ambulatory Patient Summary
 - Information flows into the Summary template based on documentation of the visit.
 - Some areas are free text that can be completed by the provider or nursing staff.
 - These are typically printed by the front office staff after the follow-up appointment has been made.
 - NOTE: This may vary by MO, refer to your practice workflow for the printing of this document.
 - OB Antenatal Testing
 - The note is created based on the fetal monitoring episode for this visit.
 - The provider will complete this note.
 - Select Other Note
 - If the patient is presenting for a Nurse/MA visit, it will be launched from this section.
 - When clicking the header, the Nurse/MA visit will be in the drop down.
 - Select free text note and enter in the necessary documentation.
 - Click **Sign/Submit** and send to provider for signature.
