

Documentation of Patient Position has been moved to Caregiver Rounding from Activities of Daily Living section in the Adult, Adult Crit Care, Pediatric, and PICU Quick View Interactive View and I & O bands. When documenting Positioning addressed, this change will allow for the patients position to be documented at the same time, and location as hourly rounding.

- Navigate to the Caregiver Rounding section in the Quick View band.
  - In Positioning Addressed, a selection of Yes or Self will open Patient Position.
