While these updates are primarily designed for Med/Surg Nursing, **many changes will be visible across additional areas due to shared documentation sections.**

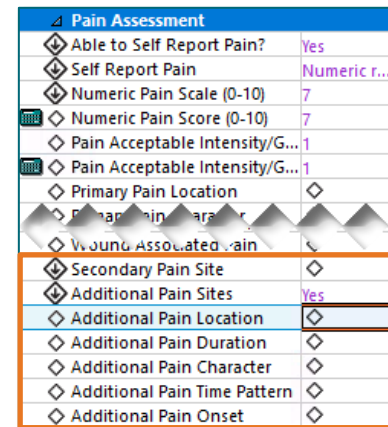

➤ Systems Assessment Bands

- **Pain Assessment**

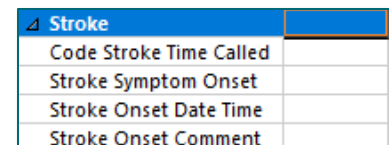
- Selecting Yes in **Additional Pain Sites** will open additional documentation fields.
 - **Additional Pain Location**
 - **Additional Pain Duration**
 - **Additional Pain Character**
 - **Additional Pain Time Pattern**
 - **Additional Pain Onset**

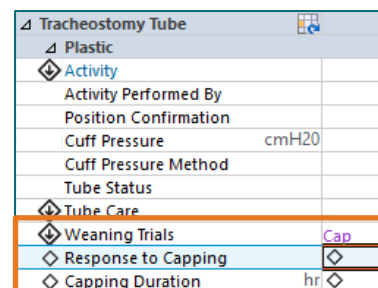
- **Ongoing Columbia Suicide Severity Rating** and **EENT** sections will no longer automatically display on the right side of the screen in iView.

- To open these sections, select them from the navigation pane to document as needed.

- **Airway Management**

- Two conditional documentation fields have been added to **Weaning Trials** and will open with the documentation of **Cap**.

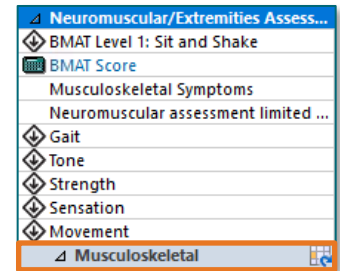

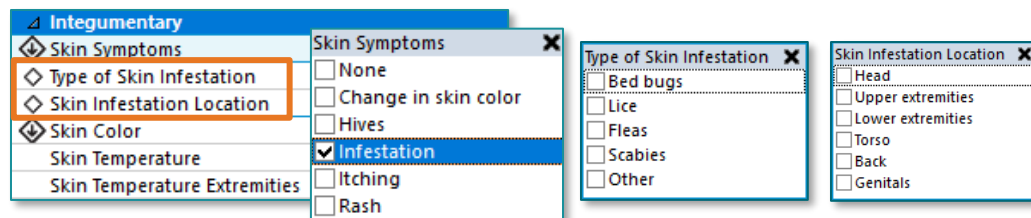
- **Neuromuscular/Extremities Assessment**

- **Neuromuscular/Extremities Assessment** will default open.
 - **Musculoskeletal** subsection is relocated within the **Neuromuscular/Extremities Assessment** and will no longer be seen as its own section within Systems Assessment.



- **Integumentary**

- **Infestation** has been added as a documentation option within **Skin Symptoms**.
 - Documenting **Infestation** opens two additional documentation fields.
 - **Type of Skin Infestation**
 - **Skin Infestation Location**



➤ **Quick View Bands**

- **Caregiver Rounding**

- **Patient Off Unit/Out of Room** has been added to document the patient is off the unit or out of their room at the time of Caregiver Rounding.

- **Activities of Daily Living**

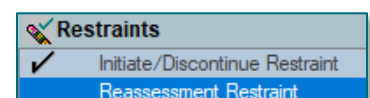
- **Hygiene ADL's**
 - **Prophylactic Foam Dressing Applied** and **Prophylactic Site Location** have been added to allow for documentation of a prophylactic silicone dressing application.

➤ **Education Bands**

- Last charted **Barriers to Learning** will automatically populate in **Teaching Method** within the **Education** iView bands, eliminating the need for duplicate documentation and quick reference when educating.
 - **For example**, if a nurse documents **Barriers to Learning** on an admission history form it will automatically populate in iView.

➤ **Restraints Band**

- Updates to the Restraints iView band have been made to align documentation with the policy.



- **Initiate/Discontinue Restraint**
 - **Family/Other Person Notify of Restraint** has been added to document if the nurse was able to contact the patient's family or other contact person.
- **Reassessment Restraint** subsection has been updated to **Every 4 Hour & PRN Documentation**.
 - **Food and/or Fluids Offered** documentation field now includes **IV fluid** and **Tube feeding** documentation options.

➤ Rapid Response and Early Warning Band

- **Early Warning and Rapid Response** iView band has been renamed to make it easier for nurses to locate.

Advanced Directive Update

Documenting 'Yes' within the Patient Wishes to Receive Further Information on Advanced Directive will fire a CareCompass task prompting the nurse to provide the Advance Directive Form.

Reminders

➤ Quick View

- **Where to document Ice and Heat applications**
 - **Ice applied, Warm blanket given, and Warm compress** are located in **Comfort Measures** within **Activities of Daily Living** under **Hygiene ADLs**.

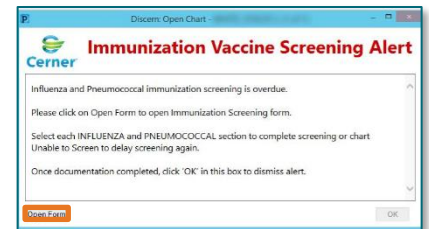
➤ Systems Assessment or Intake And Output

- **Bowel Elimination**
 - Nurses are selecting **Stooling, no difficulties** if the patient has had a BM in the last three days.
 - **Date of Last BM** should be used to document a bowel movement on the current date.
 - If the patient needs to have a BM on the day of discharge, providers should look for **Date of Last BM**.

NOTE: Documentation of Stooling, no difficulties does not necessarily mean that the patient had a BM that day.

➤ **Influenza Screening – Getting too many alerts?**

- If unable to screen for influenza or other vaccines, open the form from the alert and re-document **Unable to Screen**. This will prevent the alert from firing again for 24 hours.

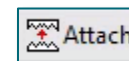
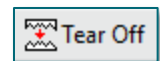


Efficiency Tips

This section highlights established workflows and serves as a reminder of the tools available to help streamline and enhance the efficiency of nursing documentation.

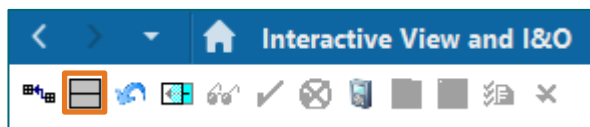
➤ **Tear Off Toolbar Icon**

- The **Tear Off** toolbar icon is a productivity tool that allows a section of the patient's chart to be **detached into a separate floating window** so two areas of the chart can be viewed at the same time.
- To return the section to the main chart, click the **Attach** button.



➤ **Split Window**

- The **Split Window** icon allows iView to display into two panes so different iView bands can be viewed and documented in simultaneously. This helps reduce scrolling and makes it easier to compare or reference documentation in separate areas of iView at the same time.



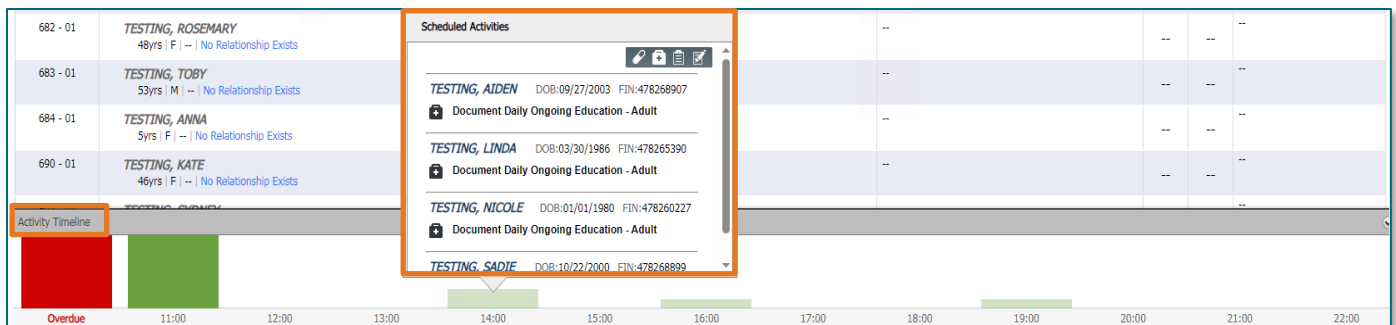
- To use **Split Window**, select the icon to split the window, then click in the bottom half of the window, and then select a different band to review or document.
- Users sign each section separately when in split window view.
- To turn off **Split Window** view, select the same icon which now shows as **Remove Split** to return to a single-pane view.

➤ **Care Compass**

- **Care Compass** is a nursing workflow management tool. Its primary purpose is to help nurses organize, prioritize, and plan patient care activities by bringing important patient information and tasks into a single view.
 - **Activities column**
 - CareCompass automatically gathers real-time information and highlights overdue tasks, upcoming scheduled tasks, STAT orders and critical results, and new provider orders requiring review.

- This helps nurses decide what needs immediate attention and what can be completed later in the shift.
- To access this to-do list, select the arrow on the right side of the patient column.
- **Activity Timeline**
 - See upcoming tasks for all assigned patients in one place.
 - The Activity Timeline makes it easier to identify priorities, organize care, and plan the shift without opening multiple patient Activities in CareCompass.
 - Click a task or patient name to open Activities for the patient.

EXAMPLE: It is almost 2:00 PM, and several tasks are due, including medications, assessments, and patient check-ins. Instead of reviewing each patient's Activity circle individually, the Activity Timeline displays all upcoming tasks in a single list. This helps prioritize care, group tasks due at the same time, and streamline workflow so more time can be spent on patient care. Select the patient task or name to open the patient's Activity to document the task. As tasks are documented, the green box will become smaller and lighter in color.



➤ Nurse View

- **Handoff Tab (MPage)**
 - **Menu**
 - The **Menu** within the **Handoff MPage** helps nurses quickly move between different sections of the patient Handoff MPage during shift change, transfers, or when assuming care of a new patient.
- **Customizable**
 - MPages are customizable so nurses can **organize and rearrange the menu components to match personal workflow**.
 - **Drag and drop sections within the menu** to place the most vital information at the top of the handoff view.
 - **For example**, a nurse may choose to see Vital Signs before Histories, while another may prefer Home Medications near the top.

- **Exit Icon**

- The **Exit** icon ends the nurse's session in Oracle Millennium and saves any personalization settings, so the preferred layout is there the next time the nurse sign in and open a patients chart.
- Exit does not replace Save/Sign/Document functions used within clinical workflow components.

➤ **Clinical Entry Workspace (CEW)**

- **Clinical Entry Workspace** provides direct access to PowerForms, charting activities, and Nursing Notes, allowing nurses to **document care more efficiently** and **reducing the need to navigate through Ad Hoc Charting**.
- Clinical Entry Workspace **only shows documentation from this encounter** and **shows most recently completed forms at the top**.
- By bringing documentation tools into a single workspace, **CEW saves clicks, streamlines workflow, and helps nurses spend less time searching for forms and more time caring for patients**.

➤ **Discharge MPage**

- **Education Favorites** improve nursing workflow by providing one-click access to frequently used patient education materials.
- Having commonly used education saved as favorites **reduces** the nurses time spent searching for education resources, support **consistent** patient teaching, **streamline** discharge and disease-specific education, and helps nurses deliver education more efficiently.

➤ **iView**

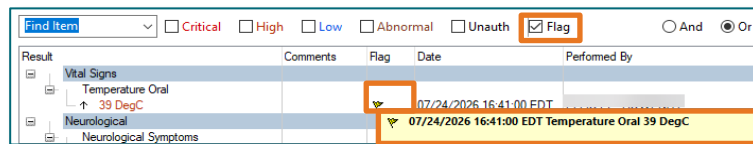
- **Flag and Flag with Comment**

- **Flag** is used to visually identify significant documented values in iView.
- **Flag with Comment** allows nurses to highlight important findings and provide additional clinical context.

- **How to Add a Flag or Flag with Comment**

- Navigate to **iView** within the patient's chart.
 - Locate the documentation cell or documented value that needs to be highlighted.
 - To add a Flag or Flag with Comment:
 - **While documenting:** Right-click within the documentation cell and select **Flag** or **Flag with Comment** before saving the value.

- **After documentation has been entered:** Select the documented value, right-click, and select **Flag** or **Flag with Comment**.
 - A **yellow flag icon** appears within the cell, indicating that the value has been flagged.
 - When entering a **Flag with Comment**, enter the appropriate clinical comment explaining the significance of the finding.
 - Save the comment.
- **How to Locate Flagged Documentation**
 - Select the **Flag** checkbox at the top of the iView page to display all flagged documentation.
 - To review a **Flag with Comment**, hover over the yellow flag icon to view the associated comment.
