

# From the Office of Clinical Informatics ED Nursing ED Triage Adult/Intake Update

September 2, 2021

The ED Triage Part Adult 1 and Part 2 forms will be replaced by the ED Triage – Adult and ED Intake – Adult. These forms have been updated to streamline the triage documentation process. The ED Pediatric Triage Forms 1 and 2 will be updated later.

# **PowerForm Name Update**

ED Triage Part 1 – Adult will be renamed ED Triage – Adult when documenting within activities on ED LaunchPoint. ED Triage Part 2 – Adult will be renamed ED Intake – Adult. These two PowerForms have been updated to streamline documentation for nursing assessment of the patient. The following information contains updated and new sections of the Triage and Intake forms.

# **ED Triage – Adult**

- Infectious Disease Risk Screening
  - The ED Triage Adult form will open to the **Chief** Complaint.
  - The Infectious Disease Screening has moved from a separate section to embedded, which aligns with documentation workflow.

NOTE: To place the patient in an isolation precaution on ED LaunchPoint, document the isolation precaution within iView by navigating to ED Interventions View


→ Environmental Safety Management → Precautions Observed.




- Demonstrates Signs and Symptoms of Stroke
  - If selecting Stroke within Demonstrates Signs and Symptoms of Stroke, a conditional response will open.

    Demonstrates Signs and
  - Document the following if applicable:
    - Stroke Symptom Onset
    - Code Stroke Time Called
    - Telestroke Services Provided
    - Telestroke Service Location
- Prearrival Interventions
  - **Prearrival Interventions** have been moved to ED Triage Adult with updated medication lists and interventions.
- Triage Interventions
  - Triage Interventions can be documented prior to being seen by the provider.

#### > Fall Risk

- Kinder1 Fall Risk replaces Morse Fall Risk, located within the Fall Risk assessment tool.
- **Kinder1** is used to quickly identify patients **18 and over** at risk for falls in the Emergency Department.
- If an adult patient meets the Kinder1 criterion, a patient is considered at risk for falls and a Fall Risk icon appears on ED

  LaunchPoint.



NOTE: Changes have not been made to the Humpty Dumpty Fall Risk Scale for pediatric patients.


#### Pain Present

- Clicking **Yes actual or suspected pain** within **Pain Present**, will allow the nurse to document the Primary Pain Location.
- Selecting Yes to Able to Self Report Pain will open the Pain Scale that will allow nursing to document based on the patient's preference and cognitive ability.

### **ED Intake - Adult**

- Family History has been removed.
- **Communications Needs/Preferences** have been added.
- Home Medications is a required field.
- Sensory Deficits is a new addition.
