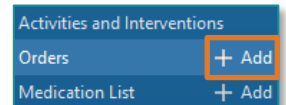


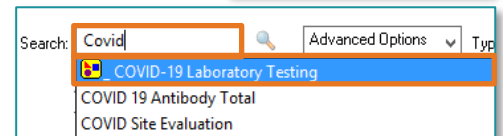
This flyer will outline the process for Clinical Staff ordering the COVID-19 Laboratory Testing PowerPlan in the Inpatient setting.

STEP 1: From the left side menu, select the **+ Add** option from the **Orders** link.



STEP 2: In the **Add Order Window**, search for **COVID** in the **Search field**.

STEP 3: Locate and select the **COVID-19 Laboratory Testing PowerPlan** from the search results.

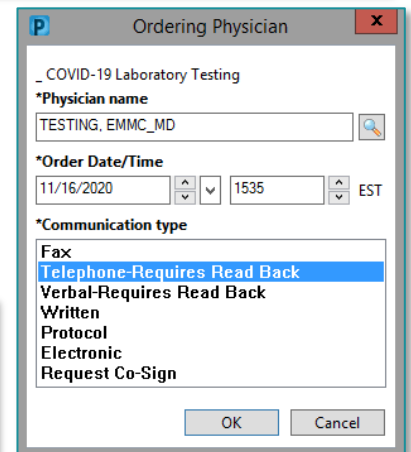



STEP 4: In the **Ordering Physician** window:

- Enter the appropriate providers name.
- Select the appropriate communication type.
- Click **OK**.

STEP 5: Click **Done** to close the **Add Order Window**.

STEP 6: Select the appropriate order page based on the criteria highlighted in orange field above the order and select **Initiate Now**.



	<p>Asymptomatic patients:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Patients with time sensitive, and medically necessary conditions undergoing aerosol generating procedures (AGP) within 12-48 hours, scheduled for C-Sections or Labor Induction, or other surgical procedures where testing will help limit the use of personal protective equipment (PPE) - Asymptomatic patients being discharged (in greater than 24 hours) to a facility that requires testing (e.g. Acadia hospital, long-term care facilities, group homes, assisted living facilities, and shelters) - Asymptomatic healthcare workers and first responders (e.g. EMS, Police, Fire, etc.) performing direct patient care who have been exposed to a known COVID -19 positive individual
<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	<p>Administrative Test for COVID 19 NASOPHARYNX, Expedite, ONCE</p>

- **COVID 19:** Used for *symptomatic* patients
- **Respiratory Virus Panel PCR:** Used for *symptomatic* patients
- **Administrative Test for COVID 19:** Used for *asymptomatic* patients who:
 - Require testing prior to Aerosol Generating Procedures (AGP) *scheduled within 24 and 72 hours*,
 - Are scheduled for a C-Section or induction,
 - Being discharged greater than 24 hours to a facility requiring testing
 - Healthcare workers and first responders performing direct patient care who have been exposed to a known COVID -19 positive individual
 - Patient (excluding newborns) being **ADMITTED** via the ED or through direct admission/transfer who has not been tested in the previous 72 hours

Ordering the COVID-19 Lab Testing PowerPlan for EMMC Inpatient Clinical Staff

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- **COVID 19 (COVID 19 for AGP, SNF, Active Labor):** Used for asymptomatic patients who
 - Require testing prior to Aerosol Generating Procedures (AGP) scheduled to occur within 12 hours.
 - Same day discharge to facility that requires testing (e.g. SNF)
 - Patient in Active Labor between the hours of 0700 and 0000
- **Rapid COVID Flu:** Used for symptomatic patients
 - Symptomatic patient in the ED
 - A transfer to Acadia from the ED
 - Laboring patients *between 0000 and 0700*

STEP 7: Fill in any Required Details in the **Order Details** section and click **Sign**.
