

The High Alert medication two nurse verification process is in place to better align with the NLH standard process. Mandatory second nurse witness documentation is now required for chemotherapy/biologics at Northern Light Cancer Care and Pediatric Cancer Care at Eastern Maine Medical Center.

High Alert Medication Verification Process

- The High Alert Medication Verification process is designed to ensure that all high-risk medications are verified by a second nurse at the time of medication administration.
 - The secondary nurse will document the medication witness within the Medication Administration Window by entering their name in the ***Witnessed by** field and selecting appropriate ***Site**, if applicable.
 - Click the green checkmark to complete charting.
 - This prompts the witness to enter their credentials.
 - Click **OK** to complete authorization.
