


FetaLink is a maternal and fetal monitoring system that facilitates the flow of data from medical devices in a manner to support display needs of clinicians in the acute and ambulatory setting. The association of the fetal monitor ensures documentation is occurring on the correct patient.

Association of the Patient to the Monitor


STEP 1: Select the location that represents the room where the patient is located.




STEP 2: Scan the patient's wristband.

STEP 3: Verify the patient information in the **Monitor Association** window.

- The patient's information will display. If the incorrect patient is displaying, click **Change Patient** and search for the correct patient.




STEP 4: Scan the label on the monitor to associate with the patient.



NOTE: If the Monitor Association window doesn't display, that indicates not signed into FetaLink.

STEP 5: Once the wristband and the monitor have been selected, verify the information is correct,

- Information to confirm includes correct location (room number), right patient, right monitor, right time (defaults to today and now).



STEP 6: Select **Apply** to complete the association.



Manual Association of the Monitor

STEP 1: From the **Census View**, select the location representing where the patient is located.

STEP 2: From the toolbar in the patient chart, select **Monitor Association**.

STEP 3: Select **Patient Search** in the **Monitor Association** window.

STEP 4: Enter the patient's FIN (if available) and select **Search**.



- If the patient's FIN isn't available, a search may be completed by Name, Date of Birth, or Medical Record Number.

STEP 5: After confirming the patient, highlight the patient's name and select **Apply**.

STEP 6: Select **Monitor Search** to launch the monitor search window.

STEP 7: Select the appropriate fetal monitor and select **Apply**.

NOTE: Until an encounter is selected, the patient's FIN and DOB will not display within the demographics bar within the single perspective view, as well as on the Census (FIN).

STEP 8: Select **Apply** to complete the association.

NOTE: When searching by Name, MRN, or DOB, an Encounter Search Box will appear for you to select the correct encounter for this fetal monitoring episode.
