FetaLink is a maternal and fetal monitoring system that facilitates the flow of data from medical devices in a manner to support display needs of clinicians in the acute and ambulatory settings. Creating a Reason for Monitoring allows clinicians to see why the patient is on the monitor and aids in more efficient retrieval of the monitoring episode for viewing after being finalized.

Create a Reason for Monitoring

To create a **Reason for Monitoring**, you must be logged into FetaLink.

<u>STEP 1</u>: From the Census view, click the Reason for Monitoring column to enter why the patient is currently being monitored.



NOTE: The Reason for Monitoring annotations cannot be edited after the initial creation; however, they can be re-entered. The most recent annotation is displayed in the Census perspective,

all annotations are viewable in the Annotations Summary.

STEP 2: In the Annotations window, enter the Reasons for Monitoring by selecting from the Quick Picks or by


entering a free-text reason.

NOTE: Remember not to document discrete data as a free text in the annotations. Use quick picks as much as possible. More than one quick pick can


be selected.

STEP 3: Select Sign.

➤ The **Reason for Monitoring** now displays.







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- ➤ When manually searching for a patient using a FIN or using the barcode scanner, the encounter search window will not open.
- ➤ When finalizing the strip, the Finalize Episode window will appear. If the reason for monitoring needs to be updated, it can be updated at that time.
