Disassociating a Patient

FetaLink is a maternal and fetal monitoring system that facilitates the flow of data from medical devices in a manner to support display needs of clinicians in the acute and ambulatory setting. When a patient's monitoring is completed, the patient needs to be disassociated from the monitor.


Disassociation of a Patient from the Monitor


STEP 1: From the patient chart in FetaLink, click the Monitor Association button.

<u>STEP 2</u>: The Monitor Association box will appear. Select Disassociate.

<u>STEP 3</u>: Verify the times are accurate, if not select **Modify** and change to the appropriate time for the disassociation.

Verify the association time and Modify if needed.





STEP 4: Select **Apply**.

After disassociation has occurred and the patient is remaining in the room, the patient will display on the census board without a monitor listed in the Fetal Monitor Column.



- The patient may drop to a hold bed after being disassociated or if the patient is transferred to another room.
 - The patient will remain in the HOLD bed until the patient's monitoring episode is finalized.
- ➤ Once the documentation for the patient is complete, the <u>finalize</u> process would be followed.
