## **Modifying the Association Time**

FetaLink is a maternal and fetal monitoring system that facilitates the flow of data from medical devices in a manner that supports display needs of clinicians in the acute and ambulatory settings. There may be times that the association time of the monitor may need to be modified.


## **Modifying the Association Time**


**STEP 1**: From the toolbar in the patient chart, select the **Monitor Association** button.

- The Monitor Association window will appear.
- The association start date and time that was previously established displays.
- <u>STEP 2</u>: Within the Monitor Association window, select **Modify**.
- STEP 3: Update the time field with the correct association time, changing the date as necessary.
- **STEP 4**: Select **Apply** to commit the changes.
  - The updated association time displays.
- NOTE: The association date/time can be back dated up to 1 week.
- NOTE: If the user doesn't remember what time the strip started, reviewing the Annotation

Summary you can find the time the strip was started.
