PowerChart Maternity provides continuity of care throughout the pregnancy with information flowing from the ambulatory to the inpatient setting. When a fetal demise occurs, documentation needs to be completed to ensure that all members of the healthcare team have access to information necessary to assist in providing high quality care.

Fetal Demise


Documentation of bereavement and expiration are entered with a Fetal Demise.

Interactive View and I&O


- STEP 1: From the maternal chart, select the **OB Special Assessment** band.
- STEP 2: Select the section Fetal Neonatal Bereavement.
- **STEP 3:** Complete the Type of Perinatal Loss, Birth Certificate, Death Certificate, and other details as appropriate per organizational policies.

AdHoc Charting

STEP 1: Select the **Expiration Record Form** in the **AdHoc** folder and click **Chart**.



- STEP 2: Complete the required fields on the Expiration Record.
- **STEP 3:** Complete the OB Fetal Demise/Neodeath section and Sign.
