


- **≻** Key Tasks

#### **Documentation of Tasks**


- Documentation in Mother's Chart.
  - From Interactive View and I&O, documentation occurs in the Newborn Delivery Data Band.
  - Newborn Vitamin K injection is documented in the Newborn Exam section. This is documented as Done or Parents refused.





NOTE: Documentation of the medication occurs from the MAW, this doesn't display on the Task Timeline and needs to be documented from Interactive View and I&O.

  - Documentation in the Newborn Discharge Checklist will display on the Task Timeline.
