




### NL Enterprise – Total Census

- Depending on the user's permissions, various dashboards may display.
- Navigate to the **NL Enterprise – Total Census** dashboard and select to open the dashboard.
  - To save the dashboard as a favorite, select the **star** icon.
  - Once saved, the dashboard can be easily accessed under **Favorites**.
- The top of the board provides a patient flow overview for the entire organization.





- **Inpatient Census:** Number of occupied beds within the system.
- **Predicted Inpatient Census:** 4-hour prediction of incoming patients.
- **Admissions:** Number of patients with an Admission order.
- **Confirmed Discharges:** Number of patients with a Discharge (DX) order.
- **Anticipated Inpatient Census:** Anticipated bed occupancy in 4 hours.
- Larger organizations will display multiple pages of information, select the **Pause Scrolling** button in the top-right corner to pause scrolling.
  - To resume the automatic scrolling, select the **play** button.



➤ Each Member Organization has a widget that displays patient flow data for the inpatient units.

➤ For each unit widget, various data is displayed.

- A: Unit Name or Service Line
- B: Number of occupied beds.
- C: Percentage of occupied beds.
- D: Number of incoming patients to the unit.
- E: Number of patients with a confirmed discharge.
- F: Legend that corresponds with the circle visual. Hover your mouse on the circle to view display additional details.
  - **Available:** The room is unoccupied and ready for the next patient.
  - **Dirty:** The room is ready for staff to clean.
  - **Cleaning:** Staff are actively cleaning the room.
  - **Blocked:** The bed cannot be used for a specified clinical reason, i.e., existing patient condition in a semi-private room, staffing issues, etc.
  - **Out of Service:** The room is not acceptable for patient use due to a non-clinical issue, i.e., maintenance needed.



➤ To return to the Command Center Dashboard homepage, select the **home**  icon at any time.
