
Due to the national blood supply shortage and to assist in clinical decision making, the Adult Red Blood Cells Transfusion PowerPlans will now display with color statuses.

Transfusion PowerPlans


NOTE: PowerPlans displaying with the color statuses are Transfuse Red Blood Cells Anemia Active Bleeding Adult and Transfuse Red Blood Cells Anemia Non-Active Bleeding Adult.

STEP 1: Checking Current Blood Supply

• Prior to placing the order for the blood transfusion, click the **Reference** icon to the left of the header to check the current blood supply.




• The intranet page will provide a current inventory to reference.



STEP 2: Selecting Appropriate Subphase


• Each color status has clinical indicators to assist in the decision-making process for placing the appropriate order for your patient.

STEP 3: Adding Orders

• After selecting orders within the appropriate subphase: Red, Yellow, or Green, return to the PowerPlan and select the appropriate medication and laboratory orders for the patient.
