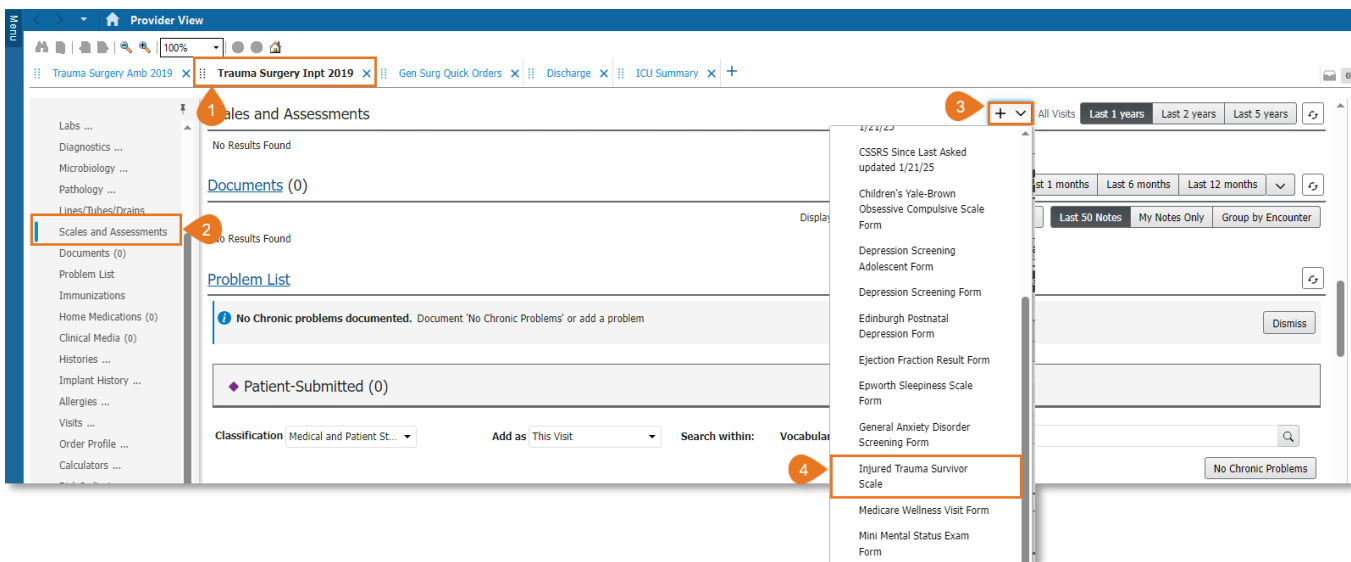


Clinicians are required to complete the Injured Trauma Survivor Scale screening for injured patients with a hospital length of stay exceeding two days. This form documents early psychological risk indicators in injured patients so care teams can intervene early, reduce long-term mental health complications, and coordinate appropriate follow-up care.

Accessing the Injured Trauma Survivor Scale PowerForm

Providers can access the **Injured Trauma Survivor Scale** PowerForm by:

1. Navigating to the **Trauma Surgery Inpt 2019 Workflow** MPage.
2. Click **Scales and Assessments** component.
3. Click the + dropdown. 
4. Select **Injured Trauma Survivor Scale** to open.

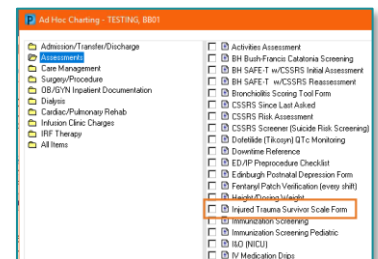


AdHoc Folder Location

The **Injured Trauma Survivor Scale Form** is available to nursing staff in the **AdHoc** folder within the **Assessments** and **Patient Care** folders.

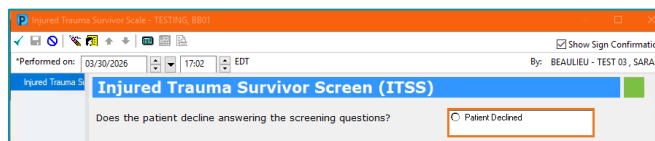
Screening Questions

- Clinicians are required to complete the **Injured Trauma Survivor Scale** PowerForm for admitted injured patients with a **length of stay greater than two days**.
- If the **PTSD and Depression Risk** screening is **positive**, an **INP Acadia Consult** order is automatically placed following patient agreement and completion of the form is signed.
- To sign, click the green check  located at the **top left** corner of the form.



➤ Patient Declination

- Select **Patient Declined** if the patient chooses not to answer the screening questions.



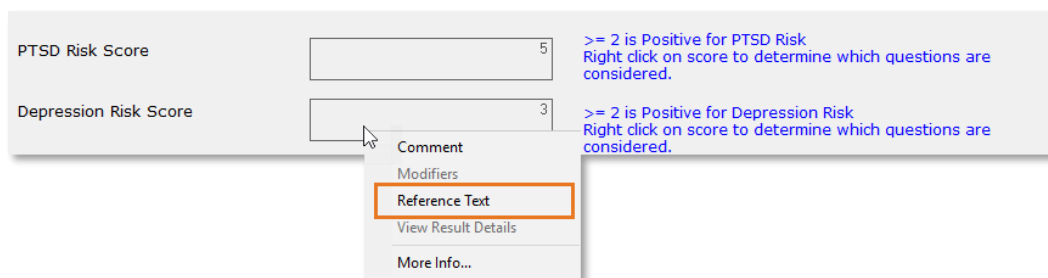
➤ Questions Assessing PTSD Risk and Depression:

- There are a series of **Yes** and **No** questions that evaluate the patient's risk as it relates to the injury.

➤ PTSD and Depression Risk Score

- Following completion of the assessment questions, the **risk score** will be calculated.

NOTE: Right-click within the risk score window to access the reference text.



➤ INP Acadia Consult Order

- If the patient agrees to a consult, select **Yes**.



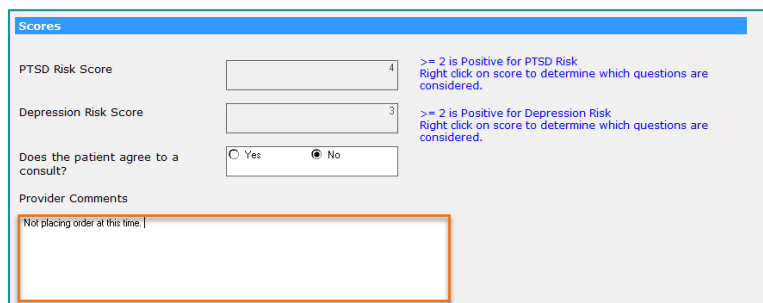
NOTE: The INP Acadia Consult order is automatically placed once the patient agrees and the form is signed. Click the green check ✓, located at the top left to sign.

- If the patient **does not** agree to a consult, click **No**.

NOTE: By selecting No, the consult order will not be placed after the form is signed.

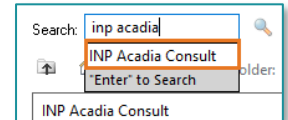
➤ Provider Comments

- Providers may add comments using the Provider Comments field.



Placing INP Acadia Consult Order after Patient Declination

Option 1: If the patient agrees to a consult later, the INP Acadia Consult order can be placed.

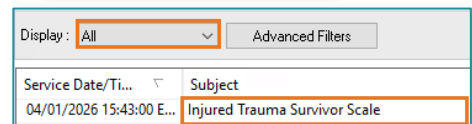


Option 2: Modify the Injured Trauma Survivor Scale PowerForm to facilitate automatic placement of the INP Acadia Consult order.

STEP 1: From Menu, navigate to Documentation.



STEP 2: Switch the Display documents filter to All.



STEP 3: Double-click on Injured Trauma Survivor Scale.

STEP 4: Click Yes to “Does the patient agree to a consult?”

STEP 5: Document Provider Comments as needed.

STEP 6: Click the green checkmark, located at the top left to sign.

- The INP Acadia Consult order will be placed.

NOTE: Form modifications will be visible after the form is signed and the page is refreshed.

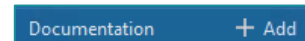
Viewing the Injured Trauma Survivor Scale and Completed PowerForm

➤ The **PTSD and Depression Risk Score** is viewed under **Scales and Assessments** of the **Trauma Surgery Inpt 2019** MPage.

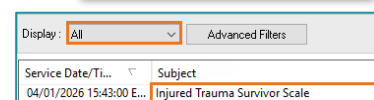
