


The PDMP/Opioid Review MPage component, as part of the Opioid Toolkit, has been revised and updated to effectively integrate new technology into provider and clinical staff workflow. This flyer discusses the new view and associated workflow.

PDMP/Opioid Review MPage component

Accessible from various workflow MPages, the PDMP/Opioid Review component is locked and cannot be removed from view; however, is able to be moved within the MPage to suit individual workflows.

- The PDMP/Opioid Review component is to be used prior to ordering or renewing a prescription for an opioid.



STEP 1: From a Workflow MPage, navigate to PDMP/Opioid Review component.

STEP 2: Data will populate in the component with the following information:

- **Drug Screens** (displays most recent screening found)
 - Click **View Details** to review **Drug Screens** results.
 - Drug screen results must be recorded in **Results Review** to be viewable in the PDMP/Opioid Review MPage component.
- **Opioid Treatment Agreement (OTA)** (displays start date of OTA and primary provider on record)
 - **None found:** OTA form has not been completed, expired, or cancelled.
 - To populate new OTA, select the dropdown arrow from within the PDMP/Opioid Review component and select **Opioid Treatment Agreement**.
 - Click **View Details** to review most recent OTA.

NOTE: The Smart Template within the most recent OTA may pull in data beyond 365 days.

- **More than 3 Opioid Rx in the last 60 days:** (*Yes/No will display)
 - Yes displays if patient has had three or more opioids prescribed in Cerner Millenium in past 60 days.
- **Co-prescribed Opioid and Benzo:** (Yes/No will display)
 - Yes displays if concurrent (and both active) opioid and benzodiazepine prescribed in Cerner Millenium.

NOTE: Excludes home medications and outside prescriptions found within the PDMP. Only prescriptions prescribed within NLH Cerner Millenium will populate data in the component.

- **Previous Overdose** (Yes/No will display)
 - Yes displays if patient has previous diagnosis of Overdose, from **Problem List** (cross-encounter no time-limit look back)
 - Yes will still display if problem has been resolved.
 - To review additional details, navigate to **Problems** component in MPage.

STEP 3: After reviewing above sections, review **Acute Opioid Administrations** and **Prescribed and Documented Opioids** sections within **PDMP Review** section.


- **Acute Opioid Administrations:** Select **View Details** to view full list of opioids administered in past 60 days. This is broken out by MME by opioid and total MME.
- **Prescribed and Documented Opioids:** includes both prescriptions and medications administered in Cerner Millenium within past 60 days with quantity, refills, MME per medication, and total MME.

Reviewing the PDMP

STEP 1: In the PDMP Review section, select **View Report**.

NOTE: Selecting **View Report** sends notification to the State the Provider has viewed the Patient's PDMP Report.


STEP 2: **Missing Terms of Use Agreement** populates under PDMP Review.


- Click the **Open** button in the bottom right.
- PDMP Review **Terms of Use** populates.

- After reviewing the Terms of Use, click **Accept** or **Cancel**.

STEP 3: Once the Terms of Use are accepted, the PDMP report expands and displays demographic information, risk indicator graphs, and prescription information (summary of total prescriptions, total prescribers, and total pharmacies).

STEP 4: Complete PDMP Review.

- After reviewing the PDMP Review, ensure the checkbox to the left of **I certify that I have reviewed the PDMP Information** is selected.

NOTE: The checkbox automatically checks after you select **View Report**.

STEP 5: Click the **Mark as Reviewed** button.

- Mark as Reviewed** confirms the physician has reviewed the PDMP in Cerner and writes a date/time stamp to the backend tables in Millennium for reporting.
- The PDMP Reviewed, date/time stamped, Provider, and a red "X" becomes a green checkmark.


STEP 6: The **Query of PDMP Measure PI** report keys off the checkbox being reviewed and provides insight into physician usage and compliance of PDMP.

NOTE: Clinical staff should use the auto text `/controlledsubstance` as a way to communicate to provider within a Note that the PDMP has been reviewed.


NL Acadia will continue to use the auto text `/bh_controlledsubstance`.

Provider Tips

- To fully capture the PDMP attestation, the checkbox for **I certify that I have reviewed the PDMP information** must be checked **AND** the **Mark as Reviewed** button is clicked.

- The **PMP Reviewed:** field in the Rx details scratchpad is **REQUIRED** for providers. I certify that I have reviewed PDMP information and **Mark as Reviewed** should also but selected this will satisfy state requirement for PDMP checking.

- **Pill Counts:** These are entered on the Controlled Substance Management Form by clinical staff. Once documented, the below auto texts can be used to pull information from the form into the note.

- /controlledsubstance *
- /controlledsubstance_MAT *
- /bh_controlledsubstance * (used by NL Acadia Hospital)

- **Signing the Attestation from Message Center.**

- Click **Summary View**.
- Click **PDMP/Opioid Review**.
- Complete **Attestation**.
