
Cerner Millennium Code Status Updates

September 9, 2019

The Code Status and Treatment Restrictions order will be updated to replace the Per Behavioral Health Policy option with an Unable to Provide Consent option. When Unable to Provide Consent is used, a New Code Status alert will fire once every 12 hours for each user to remind them to reassess and modify the details. These changes will affect all hospitals and emergency departments using the Cerner Millennium system. Please see page 2 for Acadia specific education.


Code Status and Treatment Restrictions Order Update

Due to regulatory changes the **Information Source** details in the Code Status and Treatment Restrictions order are being updated. The **Per Behavioral Health Policy** is being replaced with **Unable to Provide Consent**.



New Code Status Alert

- When opening the patient's chart, a new Code Status alert will fire for Emergency, Surgical and Inpatient providers and nurses to remind them to reassess the patient.
- The alert will fire once per user, every 12 hours for each user, until the Information Source details are modified.




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<u>Acadia Code Status and Treatment Restrictions Order Update</u>

Due to regulatory changes the **Information Source** details in the Code Status and Treatment Restrictions order are being updated. The **Per Behavioral Health Policy** that is prepopulated will no longer be a selection or populate and will require interaction within the order details to choose the appropriate Information Source.

From within the Admission PowerPlan, use the following steps to fill in all required details:

- STEP 1: Right-click on the Code Status and Treatment Restrictions order and select Modify.
- STEP 2: Within the order details, locate the **Information Source** field and select as appropriate.



New Code Status Alert

- If the **Information Source of Unable to Obtain Consent** is selected, when opening the patient's chart, a new Code Status alert will fire for Inpatient providers and nurses to remind them to reassess the patient.
- The alert will fire once per user, every 12 hours for each user, until the Information Source details are modified.
