 - Review and update as appropriate and Sign when completed.

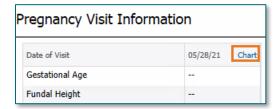
Pregnancy Visit Information

Depending on how the preferred view is set up, providers may see the Flowsheet or Card format.

Card Format



Flowsheet Hover in the Date column to display Chart



STEP 1: Click Chart.

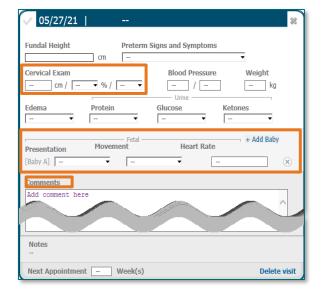
STEP 2: Enter Cervical Exam, Fetal Movement and Comments.

> Comments can be used as the visit note for established patients.

NOTE: In the event of a multiple pregnancy, click +Add Baby from within the pregnancy card.

EDD Maintenance

When an ultrasound is performed, the updated EDD, and the date of the ultrasound will be added through EDD Maintenance.



STEP 1: Click the + sign on the right-hand side of the component.

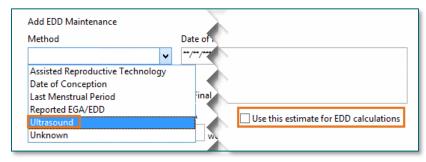

• The new date will now display as the authorative date for the pregnancy, as indicated by a checkmark.





Risk Factors

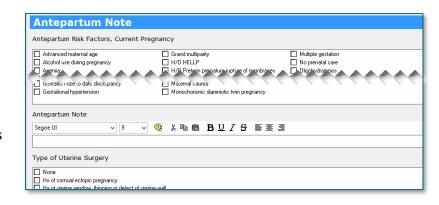
Any concerning current conditions or historic events can be documented.



<u>STEP 1</u>: Select the **Antepartum Risk Factors Form** in the drop down.

STEP 2: Complete the form as appropriate and Sign.

- If risk factors have already been added, review and update as appropriate.
- Specifically identified Risk factors will automatically be associated with the pregnancy diagnosis on the problem list, as indicated by the Comment box.



> Fetal Monitoring

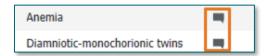
To view previous finalized strips, strips can be viewed from the Fetal Monitoring component.

• Select the episode you wish to review by clicking the box in front of the episode date and select Launch.

NOTE: If fetal monitoring is actively occurring during the office visit, the fetal monitoring episode can be viewed in FetaLink.

Allergies

 Review and Complete Reconciliation if the status is incomplete.







▶ Home Medications

Home medication reconciliation will be performed at each visit.

STEP 1: Select **Outpatient**.

STEP 2: Choose to Continue, Prescribe or Do Not Continue each medication.

 Acknowledge Remaining Home Meds if the medication is not maintained by the reviewing provider.

STEP 3: Select Reconcile: Sign.

> Problem List

Each visit must have at least one **This Visit** and **Chronic** problem.

• Select Mark as Reviewed to document the list has been reconciled.

> WH Quick Orders

Providers can select frequently ordered tests, labs, procedures, and enter charges on the WH Quick Orders MPage.
