

# From the Office of Clinical Informatics Women's Health View GYN Visit (Provider) July 28, 2020


On August 17, 2020, PowerChart Maternity will be going live. The implementation of this solution will cross from the ambulatory to the inpatient setting improving the continuity of care provided throughout the patient's pregnancy and ensures all members of the healthcare team have access to information necessary for delivering high-quality care. 
# **▶** Chief Complaint


- Nursing staff will enter the chief complaint for the patient.
- Providers can update and/or modify the chief complaint.
- Sign when complete.



## Quick Visit

- Quick Visits have been designed to create a note template for you that, depending on the quick visit, will contain diagnosis, Review of Systems, Orders, and charges.
- From the Quick Visit component, select the appropriate note for the visit, by highlighting the visit.









• Make the appropriate selections and click Submit.

• Verify order details and sign.




• In the Quick Visit component, the visit will display as submitted.

NOTE: If the visit has more than one problem for the visit or is a complicated visit, you wouldn't utilize the quick visit.


## > Recommendations

Recommendations will display screenings that are due for the patient based on age and diagnosis.




# Gynecology


• This component will display information regarding Gynecology and Pregnancy History.

  - You can modify this to be appropriate for your patient.







• The use of tagging, autotext, freetext, and Speech to text recognition may be utilized.

• Select the appropriate note type.

- Change the title of the note to reflect the visit



WH Quick Orders: Complete E & M charges and any additional orders appropriate for the visit.

NOTE: Medication, Allergy. and Problem list reconciliation are required elements of the GYN visit. In addition, at least one patient education is required for each visit.
