

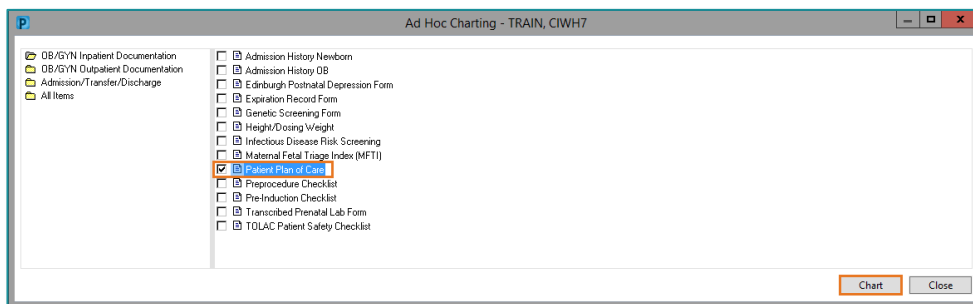
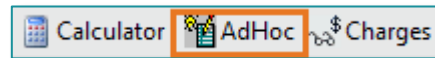

Patient Plan of Care

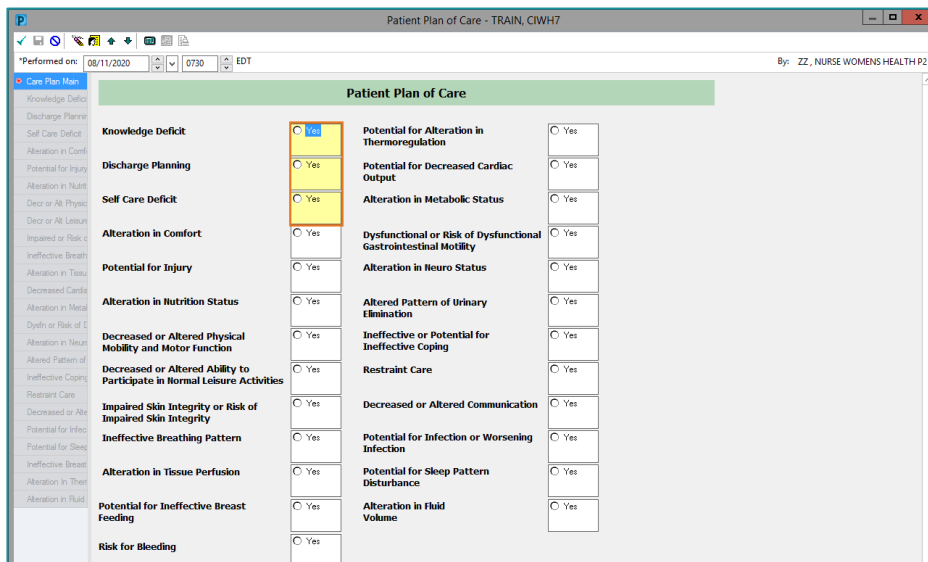
The patient plan of care is instrumental in evaluating the progress of your patient from admission through discharge and aids in helping the patient and staff identify and manage problems in specific areas. The patient plan of care has been updated to include women's health content.

➤ Patient Plan of Care

- From the toolbar, select AdHoc.
- Select Patient Plan of Care and Chart.



- Complete the required items (identified in yellow).



- Complete other sections as appropriate for the patient.

➤ **Documentation Components**

- In each section, a similar format is utilized.
 - Sections with a radio button is one selection.
 - Sections with boxes are multi-select.
- Status
 - Indicate if this is the initial patient plan of care for the identified area or if this is an ongoing update.
