

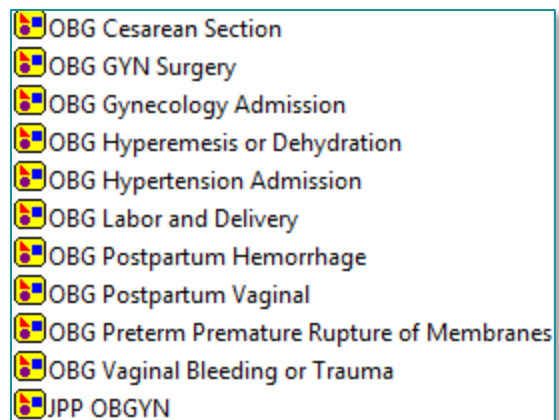

OB GYN PowerPlan

There have been new PowerPlans that have been implemented for the women's health go-live.

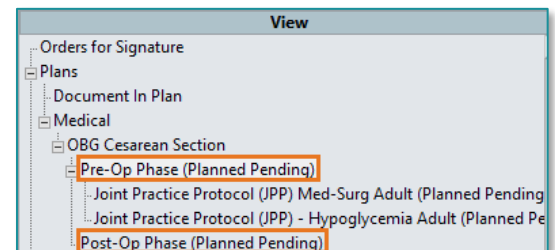
➤ OB PowerPlans

- In the Order Entry for inpatient orders, the following PowerPlans are available by searching "OB".
 - OBG Cesarean Section
 - OBG GYN Surgery
 - OBG Gynecology Admission
 - OBG Hyperemesis or Dehydration
 - OBG Hypertension Admission
 - OBG Labor and Delivery
 - OBG Postpartum Hemorrhage
 - OBG Postpartum Vaginal
 - OBG Preterm Premature Rupture of Membranes
 - OBG Vaginal Bleeding or Trauma
 - JPP OBGYN
- The utilization of these orders will aid in efficiencies when placing orders.



➤ Two-Phase PowerPlans

- The following PowerPlans are two-phase PowerPlans.
 - OBG Cesarean Section
 - OBG GYN Surgery
- From the View Menu, you can see the two-parts.
 - Pre-Op Phase
 - Complete the appropriate orders pre-op.
 - Post-Op Phase



- After the procedure, return to orders and highlight the Post-Op phase and complete the appropriate orders.

➤ **OBG Hypertension**

- Like the Surgical PowerPlans, the OBG Hypertension PowerPlan is a two-phase PowerPlan.
- This PowerPlan has an Antepartum Phase and a Labor and Delivery Phase.
 - Select the appropriate phase when treating the hypertensive OB patient.

➤ **Other OBG PowerPlans**

- The remaining PowerPlans function as a single phase PowerPlan.
- These include:
 - OBG Gynecology Admission
 - OBG Hyperemesis or Dehydration
 - OBG Labor and Delivery
 - OBG Postpartum Hemorrhage
 - OBG Postpartum Vaginal
 - OBG Preterm Premature Rupture of Membranes
 - OBG Vaginal Bleeding or Trauma
 - JPP OBGYN
