
PowerNotes will retire on Monday, September 25, 2023 for all Women's Health providers. Women's Health providers are encouraged to transition to Dynamic Documentation, as soon as possible. Instructions for requesting education on the use of the dynamic documentation tool is available.

Dynamic Documentation Education Opportunities

Dynamic Documentation education is available through an online simulation-based course and/or through instructor-led classes. Use the Self-Service Portal to request education. Also, indicate if M*Modal Fluency Direct education is needed.

➤ **Dynamic Documentation Instructor-Led Classes**

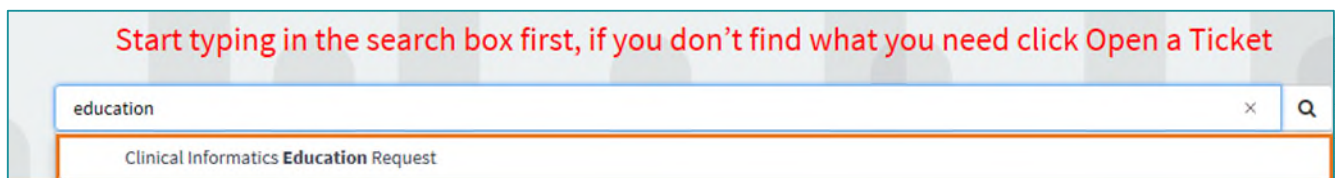
Classes are offered weekly (weekdays and frequency vary from site to site based on classroom availability). For interested parties, the classes are offered with M*Modal Fluency Direct voice-to-text education.

➤ **Online Simulation-Based Courses**

Online education can be used in place of or in addition to classroom education. This modality allows the provider to complete the education around busy schedules from the comfort of most internet enabled computers.
