To remove a day of treatment when placing cycle orders, changes will be made in the Add Plan window following the instructions below.

Skipping a Day of Treatment When Ordering a Cycle

- Examples of when to skip a day of treatment in the Add Plan window:
 - To convert an every 12 week plan to an every 6 week plan (i.e., IVIG, Zometa)
 - Only plan to give certain days of the regimen (e.g., gemcitabine + abraxane regimen that has days 1, 8, 15 every 28 days, but only plan to give days 1 and 15 every 28 days.)
- **STEP 1:** Order the regimen and click **Start** to order the cycle.
- **STEP 2**: Expand the phases by clicking the **expand** button.
- <u>STEP 3</u>: in the **Action** column, click the dropdown and select **Do Not**Order for the days not to order.
 - Perform this action in each of the applicable phases.
- **STEP 4:** When finished, click **OK** to proceed with entering orders per the normal ordering process.
