

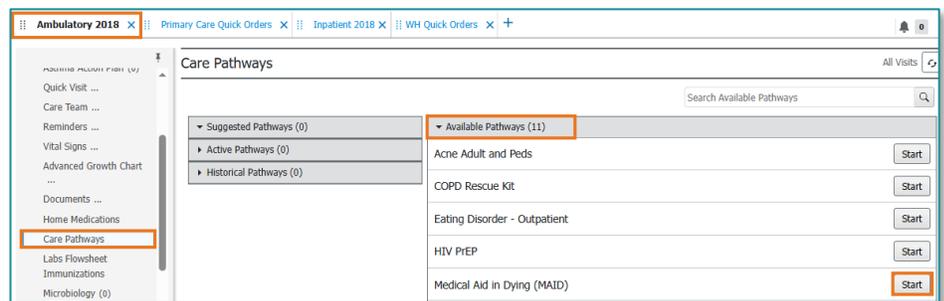
Medical Aid in Dying (MAID) will be available as a Care Pathway. The Care Pathway will support providers through each required step, streamline medication ordering, and enhance clinical confidence and safety.

## Care Pathways

Care Pathways is a component available on the Workflow MPage to assist providers with guided treatment recommendations, suggested diagnosis with specifiers, and condition-specific orders. To learn more about Care Pathways, click [here](#).

**NOTE:** Providers employed by NL Mercy Hospital may not participate in MAID.

**NOTE:** If a Care Pathway has previously been started for the patient, select Active Pathways and then open the appropriate Care Pathway.



## Initial Visit

**STEP 1:** Navigate to the Workflow MPage and select **Care Pathways** component.

**STEP 2:** Select **Available Pathways**.

**STEP 3:** Click **Start** next to **Medical Aid in Dying (MAID)**.

**STEP 4:** The **Guided Treatment** component will open.

- All questions **must be** answered.
- As questions are answered, **additional questions** *may* open to continue the pathway.

**STEP 5:** A Care Pathway may have multiple treatment lines to select. Click **Save** once the **Initial Conversation with the Patient** is complete.

## Completing Subsequent Visits

➤ **Active Care Pathways** will default open within the **Active Pathways** folder.

**STEP 1:** Select **Open** next to **Medical Aid in Dying (MAID)**.

**STEP 2:** Within **Guided Treatment**, the **Second Visit** will default open.

- All questions must be answered before proceeding.
- As questions are answered, **additional questions** *may* open to continue the pathway.

**NOTE:** Access to specific forms can be accessed through highlighting and copying the linked forms within a new browser.

**STEP 3:** Use the `/carepathways*` auto text to insert information into the office note visit.

**STEP 4:** Click Save.

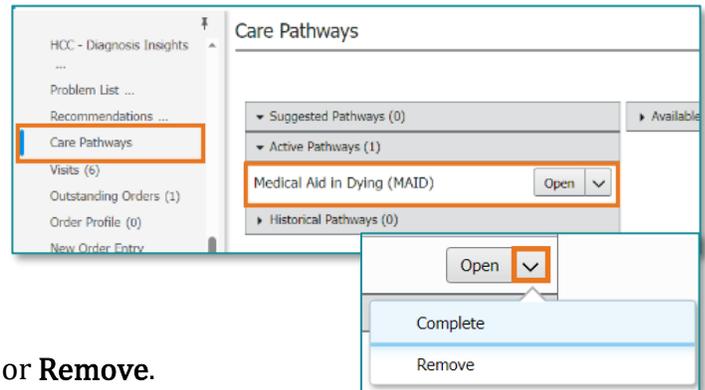
### Completing/Removing a Care Pathway

When a Care Pathway is no longer clinically indicated, or has been selected in error, the following steps should be taken to remove it.

**STEP 1:** Navigate to the **Care Pathways** component in the Workflow MPage.

**STEP 2:** Under **Active Pathways**, select the dropdown next to **Medical Aid in Dying (MAID)**.

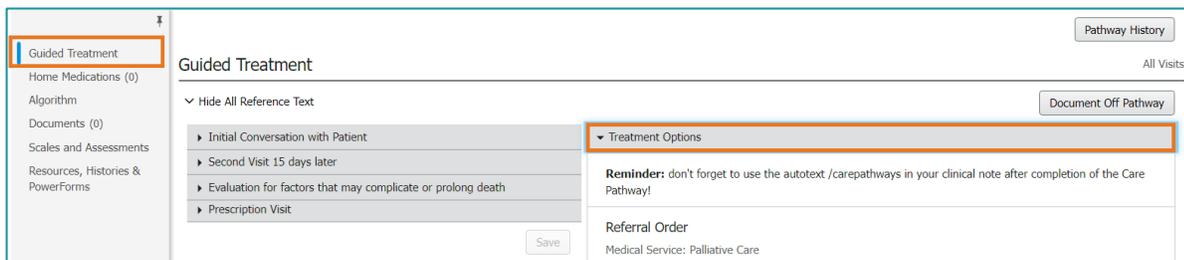
**STEP 3:** Select the appropriate option, **Complete** or **Remove**.



### Placing Referral Orders, Follow Up Appointments and Treatment Options

- Follow Up Appointments
- Prescriptions



**NOTE:** To view Treatment Options, the Medical Aid in Dying (MAID) Guided Treatment must be open.

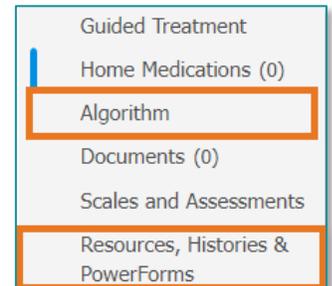
