

Overview of the Global Snapshot

- Components are used to display information most pertinent to the patient.
- Many customizations are available:
 - Changing the order of the pages
 - Rearranging components
 - Setting component filters
 - Setting components to default expanded/collapsed

- Changing the color of the components
- Adding/Removing components from view
- Changing the number of columns

NOTE:

The Global Snapshot MPage is available to PowerChart ambulatory provider positions. Additionally, users must Exit using the Exit button to save preferences.

Adding the Global Snapshot MPage

Add View : Allows the ability of adding the Global Snapshot to the new ViewPoint.

Click **Global Snapshot** under **Select a View**.

- Open a different page by clicking its tab.

Using the Global Snapshot Components

- **Header:** Each component has a header box at the top.
 - **Component Name:** The name of the components displays a hyperlink, if available. When the hyperlink is clicked, the chart will open in the corresponding location within the EHR.
 - **Expand/Collapse Icon:** In the upper right-hand corner of each component is the Expand/Collapse icon. When clicked, the component will alternate between open and close.



Add Icon: Some components contain the Add icon. When clicked, the corresponding window or link will open to enter new information into the medical record.


Customizing Global Snapshot

- Setting Components to Default Expanded/Collapsed.
 - To change whether a component defaults expanded or collapsed:
 - Click the dropdown arrow on the component's header.
 - Click **Default Expanded** to change the setting.
- Color Theme Default Expanded penicilling

- Changing the Color of Components.
 - The color of individual components can be changed.
 - Click the dropdown arrow in the header.
 - Click the desired color from the hover menu.









> Customization Menu.

- In the upper right corner of the screen, a menu is available that contains multiple options for customizing.
- Click to access options for each of the following tasks.
- **View Layout:** Allows customization of the number of columns.
- **Drag and Drop:** Allows users to drag and drop to rearrange components to suit their workflow.
- **Expand All:** When clicked, will change to Collapse All. Click **Collapse All** to make rearranging the components easier.
- **Components:** Can be unselected if they are not needed in view.

Rearranging Components.


- The order in which the components display can be changed.
- Click **Drag and Drop** in the Customization menu.
- Once drag and drop has been enabled, the cursor will change to a four-headed arrow when positioned.






> Clearing Preferences.
