MyExperience allows clinical users to choose a default organizer view in PowerChart, which provides the flexibility to meet the needs of the individual user. Staff who work in multiple specialty care areas, can switch their position dependent on the care area they are working in. This allows them to access views unique to that position.

Locating MyExperience

MyExperience is in the same row as the **Home** button.

If the MyExperience button is not on the toolbar, it may appear in the dropdown of the toolbar containing the **Home** button.

Using MyExperience

The available Organizer View varies by position.

- > My Default Organizer View
 - Used to select the desired view seen when signing into PowerChart.
- My MPages Selection
 - Used to select the appropriate position based on the specialty care area.
 - NPs/PAs have the ability to select the appropriate Specialty based on primary specialty.
 - Click Save to apply any changes.

NOTE: Physicians, RNs/LPNs, and Medical Assistants will use the Ambulatory View to select the appropriate MPage.



NOTE:

To ensure the changes are saved for the next PowerChart session, close out of PowerChart using the Exit button. When PowerChart is reopened, the selected view and/or MPage will default open.
