

From the Office of Clinical Informatics Cerner Millennium Smoking Cessation and Education Form March 23, 2020

On Monday, April 13, 2020, a new PowerForm called Smoking Cessation and Education Form will be available to allow providers to document discussion and education provided to the patient on smoking cessation. The new PowerForm has also been added to the Actions options in Recommendations. Additionally, an auto-text has been created to pull in documentation from the form when creating visit notes.

Smoking Cessation and Education PowerForm

The Smoking Cessation and Education Form is accessible from the Recommendations component under Tobacco Cessation Counseling in the Actions drop-down options. It is also available in AdHoc on the toolbar.


Documenting the Smoking Cessation and Education


STEP 1: From the Recommendations component, click Tobacco Cessation Counseling.

STEP 2: In the Actions drop-down options, click Smoking Cessation and Education Form.

STEP 3: Fill in the applicable fields in the form.

- Boxes indicate multiple options can be selected.
- Radial buttons indicate only one selection can be made.





STEP 4: Sign the form by clicking the green checkmark in the

upper left corner.

STEP 5: When creating the note for the visit, use the auto-text /pcp_smoking_cessation to pull in the documentation from the PowerForm.
