Log On Oracle Health (Cerner)

- From the Apps screen:
- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the appropriate application icon.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Enter network Username and Password; then, click **OK**. The Oracle Health (Cerner) application displays in a new window.
- **<u>NOTE</u>**: Capitalization does not matter when entering network username.
 - Capitalization does matter when entering network password.
 - To change users, use the Change button in the toolbar. The feature allows another care team member to document in a patient's chart from where the chart was opened.

Suspend a Session

- From Oracle Health (Cerner):
- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click **Suspend**.
- <u>NOTE</u>: Suspending a session locks Oracle Health (Cerner) and holds the current session in a password-protected state for up to 35 minutes. After 35 minutes elapses, Oracle Health (Cerner) logs off.

Resume a Suspended Session

From Oracle Health (Cerner):

- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the appropriate application icon. A **Resume Session** window displays.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Verify that the prepopulated username is correct; then enter network password.
- STEP 3: Click OK.
- <u>NOTE</u>: Resuming a session opens to the portion of Oracle Health (Cerner) that was being viewed before suspending it.

Log Off Oracle Health (Cerner)

- From Oracle Health (Cerner):
- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the **Exit** button to log off.
- <u>NOTE</u>: It is best practice to log out using the Exit button. Doing so ensure any updated preferences and settings are saved for future use.

Use the Recent Feature to Find Patients

- From Oracle Health (Cerner):
- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the **Recent** dropdown arrow. A menu of recently viewed charts displays.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Click the desired patient to open the chart.

Use the Search Field to Find Patients

- From Oracle Health (Cerner):
- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the **Search** field.
- <u>NOTE</u>: The current search criteria is in the Search field in grey. Use the Search dropdown arrow to update this, as needed.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Enter the appropriate search term(s); then, press **Enter**. The **Encounter Search** window displays.
- **<u>STEP 3</u>**: Use the fields to the left of the window to narrow the search, if needed.
- <u>STEP 4</u>: Click the desired patient and encounter; then, click **OK**. The **Assign a Relationship** window displays.
- **<u>STEP 5</u>**: Click the appropriate relationship; then click **OK**. The patient's chart opens.

Use the Search Icon to Find Patients

From Oracle Health (Cerner):

- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the **Search** icon.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Enter the appropriate search term(s) using the available fields; then, click **Search**.
- **<u>STEP 3</u>**: Click the desired patient and encounter; then, click **OK**. The **Assign a Relationship** window displays.
- **<u>STEP 4</u>**: Click the appropriate relationship; then click **OK**. The patient's chart opens.

View Additional Toolbar Buttons

- From Oracle Health (Cerner):
- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the **Expand** icon next to the appropriate toolbar section. A dropdown menu displays.

Rearrange Toolbar Sections

From Oracle Health (Cerner):

- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the **Vertical Dots** icon to the left of the toolbar section.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Drag and drop the section in the desired location.
- <u>NOTE</u>: Use the Exit button when closing Oracle Health (Cerner) to save toolbar changes for future use.

Add or Remove Toolbar Buttons

- From Oracle Health (Cerner):
- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the appropriate **Expand** icon.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Click **Add or Remove Buttons**.
- **<u>STEP 3</u>**: Click **Customize**. The Customize toolbar window displays.
- **<u>STEP 4</u>**: Click the appropriate option.
- **<u>NOTE</u>**: Use Add to add buttons to the toolbar using the Add User Links window.
 - Use Modify to change the custom links.
 - Use Remove to delete any unnecessary links.

STEP 5: Click Close.

<u>NOTE</u>: Use the Exit button when closing Oracle Health (Cerner) to save toolbar changes for future use.

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Rearrange Toolbar Buttons

- From Oracle Health (Cerner):
- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Click the appropriate **Expand** icon.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Click **Add or Remove** buttons.
- **<u>STEP 3</u>**: Click **Customize**. The Customize toolbar window displays.
- **<u>STEP 4</u>**: With the Customize toolbar window still open, click-and-drag buttons as needed.
- NOTE: Buttons cannot be moved between toolbars.
- STEP 5: Click Close.
- **NOTE:** Use the Exit button when closing Oracle Health (Cerner) to save toolbar changes for future use.
