### **Personalize Gadgets**

From anywhere within the Capacity Management application:

**STEP 1:** Click Personalization in the top menu bar.

STEP 2: Click My Gadgets.

STEP 3: Click a gadget to add or remove it from view.

**NOTE:** A check mark indicates that the gadget is selected.

STEP 4: Repeat steps 1 - 3, as needed.

NOTE: Click the Save icon to save any changes your make to your perspective. If you do not do this

before exiting Capacity Management, any updates to your perspective will not populate

when you log back in to the application.

Click Reset Perspective to revert everything back to default your view.

#### **Select Your Location**

From the Bed Management view in the Capacity Management application:

**STEP 1:** Click the Select Location icon.

STEP 2: Click the appropriate location.

STEP 3: Use the Right Arrow icons to narrow down to a unit or bed view, if desired.

<u>NOTE</u>: You can return to a higher-level view by clicking that option in the location toolbar, if

needed.

#### **Create a <u>Custom Favorite Location</u>**

From anywhere within the Capacity Management application:

STEP 1: Click the Add Favorites icon.

STEP 2: Click Add Custom Location Favorite. An Add Custom Location Favorite window displays.

NOTE: If you want to set your currently selected location as a favorite, you can use the Add

**Current Location option.** 

STEP 3: Use the Expand icons to drill-down and select the appropriate location.

STEP 4: Click Add.

**NOTE:** You can repeat steps 3-4 to add as many locations as needed.

STEP 5: Enter a name for your custom list in the Favorite Name field.

STEP 6: Click OK.

NOTE: Click the Save icon to save any changes your make to your perspective. If you do not do this

before exiting Capacity Management, any updates to your perspective will not populate

when you log back in to the application.

Click Reset Perspective to revert everything back to default your view.

#### **Update to a Custom Favorite View**

From anywhere within the Capacity Management application:

STEP 1: Click the Favorites icon.

STEP 2: Select your custom list.

**NOTE:** You can manage your favorites using the Manage Custom Location Favorite option.

Click the Save icon to save any changes your make to your perspective. If you do not do this before exiting Capacity Management, any updates to your perspective will not populate when you log back in to the application.

Click Reset Perspective to revert everything back to default your view.

#### View Attributes on the Bed Board

From the Bed Board gadget:

STEP 1: Click Detailed.

NOTE: Patient attributes icons display in color, while room attributes do not.

STEP 2: To return to the condensed view, click Summary.

#### Filter the Bed Board

From the Bed Board gadget:

STEP 1: Click a bed status button.

NOTE: You can select multiple bed status buttons. To reset any filters, click Clear.

#### **Search for a Patient's Location**

From the Patient List or Bed Board gadget:

STEP 1: Click Global Search.

STEP 2: Enter the patient's name, medical record number, and/or financial identification number in the appropriate field.

STEP 3: Click Search.
