

This Quick Reference Guide (QRG) demonstrates an introduction to SurgiNet.

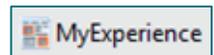
Introduction to SurgiNet

SurgiNet is an electronic medical record solution used by Northern Light Health as a tool for surgical patients. From here access and organize clinical patient information and perform functions that support clinical practice such as entering surgical documentation.

Introduction to SurgiNet

➤ From the Perioperative Tracking screen, logged in from the Surgical Nurse p1 position:

STEP 1: Click **My Experience** in the toolbar to view the tools within the SurgiNet Organizer window.



STEP 2: Click **Perioperative Tracking** in the toolbar to view options unique to the Surgical Nurse p1 position, including viewing the current day's cases and relevant information about each patient in the lower pane.



NOTE: This page is view only.

STEP 3: Click **Case Selection** in the toolbar to check in patients.



NOTE: The **Select By** option allows information to be retrieved by using the method that works best.

STEP 4: Click **Dynamic Tracking** to view the current day's cases with manipulation of surgical schedules by the charge nurse allowed.



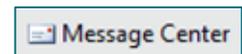
STEP 5: Click the **Toolbar Expansion** icon to view hidden toolbar options in a dropdown list.



NOTE: Pref Card Maint is used to build and maintain preference cards (make sure to follow the facility's procedures regarding building and maintaining preference cards).

- Charge Review launches SurgiNet's charge review.
- Batch Charge Entry launches the SurgiNet Batch Charge Entry.
- Charge Viewer opens the SurgiNet Charge Viewer.

STEP 6: Click **Message Center** in the toolbar to see where the PAT RN can review and send messages during Preadmission Testing.



NOTE: To send a message to a surgeon as a PAT RN, use the **Communicate** dropdown arrow.



STEP 7: Use the **Recent** dropdown arrow to quickly navigate to recently opened patient charts.



NOTE: In the patient chart, note the addition of the Perioperative Summary section in the Main Menu. The Perioperative Summary section contains the Preoperative Summary MPage, as well as the Intraoperative Summary and Postoperative Summary MPages.

STEP 8: Click the **Preoperative Summary** dropdown arrow to view additional MPage options.

STEP 9: Then, click any of the MPages to navigate to them.

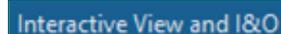
STEP 10: Click **Nurse View** in the Menu; then click the **Preprocedure Workflow** dropdown arrow to select from views that are unique to surgical nurse positions, including Preprocedure, Patient Info & Story, and ASC Recovery & Discharge Workflow.

STEP 11: Click **Perioperative Doc** in the Menu to document pre, intra, and post-operative stages.
