This Quick Reference Guide (QRG) demonstrates the pediatrician newborn workflow.

#### Women's Health Pediatrician Newborn Workflow

Review this workflow to aid in the care of newborns in the Well Newborn nursery.

### Complete the Newborn Nursery Overview

From the Provider View:

STEP 1: Click the **Tracking Board** option.

The Tracking Board displays.

Information here is organized into columns for each patient and may vary depending on **NOTE:** 

when the nurse imports the data. If the baby is seen right after delivery, information may not

be in the chart immediately.

STEP 2: Click the blank **Patient Selected** field.

The Assign a Relationship pop-up box displays.

Click Consulting Physician. **STEP 3**:

STEP 4: Click OK.

The Neonate MPage displays.

# Complete the Neonate MPage

From the Neonate MPage:

STEP 1: Click Neonate Weights and Measurements.

> The Weights and Measurements component displays the weight and head circumference in a timeline. The timeframe can be altered from present to the previous 72 hours.

Click Task Timeline. STEP 2:

> The Task Timeline displays and provides visibility into important elements of care to be completed during a newborn's stay.

STEP 3: Click Vital Signs.

> The patient's vital signs display and can be sorted based on date and time and can also be displayed in either list or graph format using the toggle options.

**NOTE:** Generally apneic events are not used within our general newborn nurseries and would be

documented in the Apnea Bradycardia Desaturation component if available.

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**STEP 4**: Click **Order Profile**.

The Order Profile displays recent orders.

**STEP 5**: Click **Hyperbilirubinemia**.

• The infant bilirubin level, time of draw and method (transcutaneous or serum) is graphed to display the risk prediction.

**STEP 6**: Click **Phototherapy**.

When phototherapy is initiated, how the infant is progressing is presented in graph format.
Scroll down to review the graph legend to aid in interpreting the results.

<u>STEP 7</u>: Scroll down in the Neonate MPage component list, then click the **Advanced Growth Chart** component.

 The Advanced Growth Chart is now available on this page. Additionally, the Scales and Assessments component displays and is where the patient's Ballard Score is documented.

**STEP 8**: Scroll down to the end of Neonate MPage component list.

 A list of Dynamic Documentation templates displays; from the list select the appropriate one to create notes.

**STEP 9**: Select the appropriate Dynamic Documentation template to create the note.

# **Review Additional Summary Reports**

From the Provider View:

**STEP 1**: Click the **Expansion** arrow next to the New Sticky Note option.

**STEP 2**: Click the **Related Records** option.

The mother's chart displays.

NOTE: When the infant's chart is open, toggle back and forth between both charts.

**STEP 3**: Scroll down the Menu list.

**STEP 4**: Click **Pregnancy Summary Report**.

The Pregnancy Summary Report displays information from the onset of pregnancy until the delivery of the baby and summarizes the prenatal course of care.

**STEP 5**: Scroll down on screen to review the remainder of the report.

**STEP 6:** Click the **X** to close the Pregnancy Summary Report.

**STEP 7**: Click the **Neonate Overview** header.

• The Results Review screen displays defaulted to the delivery record where a quick overview of the patient's documented results can be viewed.

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•	Here information can be reviewed that was copied from the mother's to the infant's chart in
	Results Review and organize the patient's results into specific areas using the Navigator
	section.
